PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. FRA 175 was sailing on starboard tack clear ahead of USA 152 when she entered the zone.

- 2. When FRA 175 was at the mark, USA 152 got inside FRA 175.
- 3. There was contact between USA 152 kite and FRA 175 kite and bridle.
- 4. Kites got tangled and there was damage on FRA 175: kite was broken and bridles were broken.
- 5. Both boards retired from the race.
- 6. At the moment of the collision FRA 175 was 3rd and USA was 3rd to 5th.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules:

1. USA 152 not overlapped with FRA 175 and not in the zone at the time FRA 175 reached the zone, failed to give FRA 175 mark-room, and broke RRS F2.18.2(a)(2).

The protest is upheld. Since USA 152 took an applicable penalty, she is not further penalized under RRS 64.2(a). However, the incident is counted to determine the number of tangles the kiteboard has caused during the event under RRS F5.64.2(c).

Redress not given to FRA 175 as her finishing order was made worse by the tangle.
