## The following changes to the A Class Catamaran Championship Rules are approved for the 2022 A Class Catamaran European Championships under Championship Rule 17.2

## Championship Rule 5.4 (Changed to read)

Each Boat shall present only one set of equipment except battens. Subsequent to measurement, no alteration or substitution to this equipment is permitted except as provided in these rules. The Technical Committee may allow replacement of any items damaged beyond repair to continue the event. Replacement items must measure within the A Class rules to the satisfaction of the technical committee.

Championship Rule 8.2 (Changed to read) The Start Line and Finish Line shall be as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

Championship Rule 8.4 (Deleted)

Championship Rule 9.1 (Changed to read)

Notice to competitors, including any changes to the Schedule of Races or the Sailing Instructions shall be made on the official notice board and/or online notice board if available.

Championship Rule 10.1 (Changed to read)

A race shall be abandoned if no boat has finished within 75 minutes. Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat shall be deemed not to have finished and shall score as a DNF.

Championship Rule 12.1 (Changed to read)

Protests shall be written on the forms available from the host club Regatta Office or online if available no later than (1) hour after the last boat in each discipline has finished their last race of the day, or no more racing today is signaled.

Championship Rule 12.2 (Changed to read) The first sentence of RRS 44.1 is changed as follows: "A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing"

Championship Rule 14.3 (Changed to read) Trophies or prizes shall be awarded to the top 5 places in both Open & Classic Discipline fleets.
