I was sailing upwind and was very aware that the jury was following me almost the whole second upwind because I was winning the race, so I was even more cautious on my technique and prioritize not to move. I weight 33kg and I'm 1m47cm tall and it was blowing 12-14kn, this is full hiking conditions for someone of my physique and conditions that requires to bail constantly while going upwind. For bailing I need to go in all the way because my arm is shorter than the rest, because I don't do that I cant reach the water. Then to bring the water out I have to move my arm fast out because if not I cant carry the bailer full of water in other way given my physique. The jury maybe didn't see that I was bailing and needed to move in and out to do so. I understand rule 42 and body pumping but moving the body in and out to be able to bail upwind while hiking is part of the technique that requires this boat.
