PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Victoria did not attend. The hearing was continued in their absence per RRS 63.3(b)

FACTS FOUND

- Both Temujin and Victoria were approaching the race committee signal vessel, both on starboard tack but not
 overlapped, 30 seconds before the starting signal.
- 10 seconds before the start, Victoria gained a windward overlap with Temujin, and contacted Temujin's starboard aft quarter with her bow and caused damage to Temujin.
- · Temujin protested.
- Victoria did one tack and one gybe shortly afterwards and then and continued sailing.
- 1hr 45mins later, Victoria retired from the race after noticing damage to her own boat.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: 11, 14

- 1. Victoria to windward failed to keep clear of Temujin to leeward, and broke RRS 11.
- 2. Victoria did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for Temujin, the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with Victoria when it was clear that Victoria was not keeping clear. Temujin did not break RRS 14.
- 4. Victoria failed to exonerate herself according to RRS 44 which requires atwo-turns penalty as soon as possible after the incident or retirement at the time of the incident

Victoria is DSQ from Race 8.
