PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Hearing No. 1 was heard together with Hearing No. 2 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind was 10 to 12 knots; smooth seas.
- 2. GURLI was on port tack approaching a windward mark to be round to port. GURLI was laying the mark about one boat length from the mark.
- 3. JBoss was on starboard tack on the lay line to pass the mark.
- 4. GURLI tacked from port to starboard one boat length from the mark on the the layline in front of JBoss.
- 5. GURLI speed slowed and JBoss was unable to change course to avoid GURLI.
- 6. As GURLI was being to round the mark, JBoss made contact with GURLI over GURLI port side transum causing damage to GURLI and JBoss.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 10 15

- 1. GURLI on port failed to keep clear of JBoss on starboard, and broke RRS 10
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for JBoss the boat sailing within the room to which she was entitledthe boat to avoid contact with GURLI when it was clear that GIURLI was not keeping clea JBoss did not break RRS 14.
- 3. Since RBoss was compelled to break RRS12 as a consequence of GURLI breaking RRS 10, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(a) for this breach.
- 4. When acquiring right of way through her own actions, GURLI failed to initially give JBoss room to keep clear, and broke RRS 15.
