PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1. GRE was not present when the hearing started at 16:50. Hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).

- 2. GRE, Dimitra Vartolomaiou (helm), came into the hearing room at 16:55, after the validity had been established and USA was presenting her initial statement
- 3. GRE requested some time to get her crew who would be the representative. An allowance of time was granted.
- 4. USA was represented by Vanessa (helm) and GRE was represented by Metaxia Gogou (crew).
- 5. The hearing was heard with a panel of four members in accordance with RRS N1.4.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind speed was 5 knots and the sea-state was flat.
- 2. USA clear astern of GRE, both boats were on starboard tack approaching the starting line.
- 3. GRE was stationary with her sails luffing on a course slightly below close-hauled.
- 4. USA established an overlap to leeward of GRE, 20s to start.
- 5. The gap between the two boats was 1m when the overlap was established.
- 6. 6 seconds after the overlap was established, GRE bore away and immediately USA also bore away, the gap between the two boats narrowed to half a meter.
- 7. There was no contact and no penalty was taken.
