





# NOTICE OF RACE OPEN CROATIAN NATIONALS MOTH CLASS

May 12-14, 2023

# ORGANIZING AUTHORITY Sailing Club Split in co-operation with Croatian Sailing Federation (HJS)

# 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1. The rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2021-2024);
- 1.2. International Moth Class Rules available at: <u>http://www.moth-sailing.org/;</u>
- 1.3. In case of a conflict between the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, latter shall apply. This changes RRS 63.7.
- 1.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

# 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to boats of the International IMCA Class.
- 2.2. No skipper shall be eligible to enter Croatian National Championship unless they are registered at Croatian Sailing Federation (applies to Croatian sailors only).
- 2.3. Eligible competitors may enter by completing the online entry form on (Google Form) available on <u>https://Google Form Moth Nationals</u> and paying the appropriate entry fee.
- 2.4. To be considered an entry valid, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees (kindly see Payment deadlines as per NoR 4.1.)
- 2.5. Entries must be received no later than Sunday, 7.5.2023.
- 2.6. Late entries may be accepted by the discretion of the Organizing Committee with a late entry fee. However, no entry shall be accepted after the mandatory registration which is scheduled on Friday, 12.5.2023. from 9 to 10 AM.
- 2.7. Competitors can request the cancellation of their entry by sending the Organizing Committee an email to: jk.split@gmail.com. If a request is made latest on Sunday, 7.5.2023. and is accepted by the OC, the entry fee will be reimbursed after deduction of an administrative fee of 20 EUR. No refund will be made if the cancellation is received after 7.5.2023.
- 2.8. All online entries shall be personally confirmed at the Race Office, during the scheduled mandatory registration (see NoR 5.1).









## 3. ADVERTISING

3.1. In accordance with WS Regulation 20 (Advertising Code), boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

## 4. ENTRY FEE

- 4.3. Entry fee includes a personal gift and a daily event after sailing.
- 4.4. In case of a cancellation after 7.5.2023. or a no-show, no entry fee shall be refunded. (see NoR 2.7.)

# 5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Mandatory registration will take place on Friday 12.5.2023. from 9 to 10 AM at the Race Office.
- 5.2. Races are scheduled on May 12, 13 and 14, 2023.
- 5.3. Three races per day are scheduled.
- 5.4. First warning signal on the first day of race is scheduled at 1 PM.
- 5.5. On the last day of race, no warning signal shall be given after 4 PM.
- 5.6. Daily event for competitors will be organized after sailing on Friday 12.5.2023. and Saturday 13.5.2023. powered by LAB Split Craft Brewery BARBA.
- 5.7. Prize giving ceremony will be organized on Sunday 14.5.2023. after publishing the final results.

# 6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1. All boats and equipment must be in compliance with the IMCA Class rules.
- 6.2. Measurement spot checks may occur.
- 6.3. Each boat shall display the unique sail number that matches their hull, in a colour that contrasts with their sail colour.
- 6.4. Competitors shall not change rudders, dagger boards or foils while afloat. Any change of rig, or foils shall be made ashore at the regatta venue.

# 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available online, on the Regatta's official Notice Board (Racing Rules of Sailing) no later than 8 PM on Friday 11.5.2023.
- 7.2. No printed copies will be handled. This changes RRS, Appendix L.

# 8. VENUE

8.1. Courses will be set in Kaštela Bay or Split Channel.









## 9. COURSES

9.1. The courses to be sailed will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

## 10. SCORING

- 10.1. A minimum of 3 races must be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.3. When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.4. When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## 11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 11.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 11.2. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 12. PRIZES

- 12.1. Prizes for the Croatian National Championship will be awarded by the Croatian Sailing Federation to the first three (3) Croatian competitors, respecting the Croatian Sailing Federation rules for awarding national titles.
- 12.2. Prizes for the Open Croatian Nationals will be awarded by the Sailing Club Split to the first three (3) competitors.

## 13. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

13.1. By entering the Regatta competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, re-use, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

## 14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
