PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind was about 7 knots and sea state was 1.
- 2, IND 24 and IND 6 were sailing downwind towards the leeward mark on Leg 5, both on port tack.
- 3. IND 24 was clear ahead and approximately one boat length leeward of the track of IND 6.
- 4. IND 6 established a windward overlap on IND 24.
- 5. IND 24 gradually luffed towards IND 6 but IND 6 did not respond and continued sailing her course.
- 6. Contact occurred between the boom of IND 6 and the shroud of IND 24.
- 7. There was no damage or injury.
- 8. Neither boat took any penalty turns.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: 11, 14, 43.1(c)

- 1. IND 6 to windward failed to keep clear of IND 24 to leeward and broke RRS 11.
- 2. IND 6 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.

3. IND 24 the right-of-way boat did not act to avoid contact when it became clear that IND 6 was not keeping clear. IND 24 broke RRS 14.

4. Since IND 24 was right-of way boat and the contact did not cause damage or injury, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(c) for breaking RRS 14.

IND 6 is DSQ in Race No 1
