### **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

1304 was represented by Aryan.

1603 did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).

### **FACTS FOUND**

The wind was 6 to 8 knots and there were no waves.

1304 and 1603 were sailing close-hauled towards the windward mark.

1304 was on starboard tack and 1603 was on port tack.

The boats were on a converging course.

Neither boat changed course and contact took place between the midships of 1603 and the bow of 1304.

There was no damage or injury.

Neither boat took a penalty.

# **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

Rules: Rules 63.3(b), 10, 14, 43.1(c)

- 1. 1603 on port failed to keep clear of 1304 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
- 2. 1603 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. 1304 the right-of-way boat did not avoid contact with 1603 when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 4. Since 1304 was right-of-way boat and the contact did not cause damage or injury, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(c) for breaking RRS 14.

### **DECISION**

1603 is DSQ in Race No 10.
