7. Description Of Incident

Lazarus on starboard tack Layline approaching mark 1.

Upon entering the three boat length zone. Lazarus on tight Starbard tack lay line and b light on Port Tack.

Danish boat to windward of Lazarus keeping clear.

Be light approach the mark on Port Lay line. Tacking from Port to Starbord, right on the mark establishing an over lap as tack is completed.

Blight aggressively luffed to get around mark. Lazarus tried to keep clear but not enough room or opportunity was provided.

Lazarus hailed windward Boat to keep clear, however sufficient room and opportunity was not given for both Boats to avoid collision.

Subsequently, Lazarus wings collided with Hungarian Boat and substantial damage was made to the wing breaking in three places and unable to complete race 11 and subsequent races the following day due to a repair, taking at least 24 hours.

Lazarus alleges Be light broke rule 18.3, 14 and 16.1, causing serious damage, Lazarus is requesting reddress for race, 11, and races on Friday 30th due to repair taking 24 hours to complete.
