NOTICE OF RACE

1. VENUE

Penang Governor's Cup Regatta 2020 will be held on the 25th Mac 2022 to 27rd Mac 2022 at the Pusat Pelayaran Pulau Pinang Batu Maung, Penang

2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

- 2.1. The event is hosted by state of Penang is organized by Penang Sailing Association (PESA) and Majlis Sukan Negeri Pulau Pinang (MSNPP) under the auspices of the Malaysian Sailing Association (MSA).
- 2.2. This Organizing Authority shall appoint an Organizing Committee and a Race Committee.

3. RULES

- 3.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 3.2. The Class Rules of the participating classes.
- 3.3. No national prescriptions will apply.
- 3.4. Rule RRS Appendix "P" will apply for the relevant classes
- 3.5. If there is conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (SI's), the SI's will take precedence (changes RRS: 63.7).
- 3.6. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

4. ADVERTISING

Boards/Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

5. **EVENT CLASSES & CATEGORIES**

- 5.1. This event will consists of categories and classes as follow:
 - 5.1.1. Optimist Overall, Optimist Divisions and Optimist Girl
 - 5.1.2. Optimist Junior Boy & Girls
 - 5.1.3. **ILCA 7, ILCA 6 Men & Women and ILCA 4 Boy & Girls**
 - 5.1.4. Int 420 Open
 - 5.1.5. **Int 470 Open**
 - 5.1.6. Windsurf Bic Techno Boy & Girls
 - 5.1.7. Windsurf RS-One Men & Women
- 5.2. A minimum of 4 entries is required to form a class event. If the minimum number of 4 entries is not received for any particular class, the decision to allow the event to be included will be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority. The OA may combine the male & female to be an Open Class event or combine the different classes as Open class.

6. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 6.1. The regatta is open to all boats/boards listed of the competing classes.
- 6.2. A minimum of 4 entries in each class is required to constitute a class of event.
- 6.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it by email before **10 Mac 2022** to: Hamdan Bin Mohd Rozi Email : hamdan.usptn47@gmail.com
- 6.4. Participant may enter more then 1 classes for **ILCA Classes** and **Windsurfing Classes** as listed in the Entry Form
- 6.5. Age Division:
 - 6.5.1. For Optimist class shall be under 16 years of age (born on 2007 or after) and for sub division will be:
 - 6.5.1.1. Division 'A'- born on between 2007 to 2009
 - 6.5.1.2. Optimist Division 'B' - born in between 2010 to 2011
 - 6.5.1.3. Optimist Division 'C' - born on 2012 or after
 - 6.5.2. ILCA 4 class shall be under 18years of age (born on 2005 or after)
 - 6.5.3. Bic Techno 293 class shall be under 18 years of age (born on 2005 or after)
- 6.6. For **Optimist Junior** :
 - 6.6.1. Participants have never participated in any competition abroad (outside their state)
 - 6.6.2. For Optimist age Division are as follow:
 - 6.6.2.1. Optimist Junior Boy & Girls 15 under – born on 2007 or after.
- 6.7. The following shall be present upon registration day:
 - 6.7.1. Original Entry Form
 - 6.7.2. Proof of age (IC or Passport)
 - 6.7.3. Proof of COVID 19 RTK SWAB test or Saliva Self Rapid Test.
 - 6.7.4. Proof of vaccination requirement as described in para 22

7. **ENTRY FEE**

- 7.1. RM100 per participant for all classes
- 7.2. This fee will cover lunch on race day, goodies if any, certificate of participation and the cost of any social events during the championship.

8. COMPETITION FORMAT

- 8.1. **7 races** are scheduled with at least 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series for an event

9. SCHEDULE

- 9.1. Schedule of event are as follows:

- 9.2. There shall be no more than 3 races per day except 1 extra race can be sailed if there is any race's behind the scheduled
- 9.3. No Warning Signal will be made after 1500 hours on the last racing Day Sunday, 27 Mac 2022.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instruction will be available during registration at the Race Secretariat on Thursday, 25 March 2022.

11. RACING AREA & THE COURSES

- 11.1. The diagrams in Attachment 1 show the racing area to be sailed.
- 11.2. Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 12.1. Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5(b).
- 12.2. RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply.

13. SCORING

- 13.1. Low point scoring system of Appendix A RRS will be apply 13.2. At least 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 13.3. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 13.4. When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14. PERSONAL BUOYANCY

Except as stated in the class rule; all competitors shall bring their own personal buoyancy which must be capable of being fastened at all time while afloat, RRS 40 will be applied.

15. LIABILITY

Participants compete entirely at their own risk and responsibility.

The Organizing Committee and all others involved in the Organization of the Championship accept no liability for any injury, damage, loss or claim whether personal or material, incurred by or inflicted to participants before, during or after the Championship.

16. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be identified with a green flag with a corresponding course letter to be displayed on a staff attached to the support boat. Boats not displaying the flags shall not enter the racing areas.

17. BERTHING/BOAT PARKING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

18. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

19. BOAT CHARTER

- 19.1. Other Competitors are required to bring their own boats. However limited numbers of boats are available for charter. The sailors who have responded to our request of indicating their charter requirement at the preliminary registration will be given preference.
- 19.2. Please contact the person below for any further information

20. PRIZES

- 20.1. Medals will be awarded to the top 3 winners of each classes except for Optimist Overall will be for top 10 winners.
- 20.2. Best sailors' winner will be based on their best result in every race.
- 20.3. Best team winner will be based on the result of their participants in each category and most participants (each entry will get 1 point)

21. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- 21.1. By participating in an event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority, their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition and after without compensation.
- 21.2. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.
- 21.3. The top three competitors as well as the individual race winners may be required to attend a media press conference each day if any.
- 21.4. Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta

22. COVID 19 MITIGATION REQUIREMENT

- 22.1. All Participants, team leaders, coaches and support staff shall adhere to the event COVID 19 Protocol as Publish.
- 22.2. All Participants, team leaders, coaches and support staff must complete 2 dos vaccination. A competitor/s which does not complete the vaccination must be accompanied by parents which have completed 2 dos vaccination.
- 22.3. The race venue will be close to the general public. All participants, team leaders, coaches And support staff must register with the Organizing Authority to obtain accreditation to access the Venue.
- 22.4. To Obtain Accreditation all Participants, team leaders, coaches must present a Negative Covid 19 RTK SWAB test result no older than 72 hours or Saliva Rapid Test Result on a day of registration before entering the race venue.
- 22.5. Accreditation to enter the venue may be revoked by the Organizing Authority if a Person is found breaching the following requirement:
 - (a) Persons attending the event shall be screened for body temperature and register and screen My Sejahtera before entering the venue.
 - (b) Persons attending the event shall observe a physical distance to others at least 1(one) meter.
 - (c) Persons attending the event should wear a properly fitted suitable face mask while ashore at the venue.
 - (d) Persons attending the event should use hand sanitizer before entering the venue and before entering the race offices, the changing rooms and any other office buildings.
 - (e) Persons attending the event should be required to submit to a Covid 19 PCR Swab Test when requested to do so by the OA.
- 22.6. Persons who display suspected symptoms as determined by a medical staff appointed by the OA against the Event COVID19 Protocol or who test positive for Covid 19 may be excluded from accessing the venue and shall be reported to the local health authorities.
- 22.7. It is the responsibility of the participant to report any suspected symptoms, commit to self-isolation, and follow the instructions of the local health authorities until a Covid 19 PCR swab test produces a negative result.

23. SINGLE USE WATER BOTTLE AND PACK FOOD IN PLASTIC CONTAINER

- 23.1. All competitors and officials are requested not to bring a 'single Use' plastic bottle, plastic food containers or any plastic to the venue and racing area on water.
- 23.2. Drinking water can be refilled from water dispensers available at race secretariat area ashore and from RC boat on water.
