PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. The hearing started at 17:45.
- 2. Cases 12 and 14 are heard together as the initiator submitted the same case twice.
- 3. ARG was represented by Paro (helm) and GBR was represented by Emily (helm).
- 4. The hearing proceeded under RRS N1.4(b) with three judges.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind speed was 6-8 knots and the sea-state was flat.
- 2. 15s to start, GBR from clear astern of ARG established an overlap to her windward.
- 3. The gap between the two boats was half a boat length.
- 4. When the overlap was established, ARG was slightly above a close-hauled course and GBR was slightly below a close-hauled course.
- 5. After the overlap was established, ARG bore away and GBR also bore away below a close-hauled course.
- 6. The gap between the two boats narrowed to 1m.
- 7. At the starting signal, the crew of ARG went out onto the trapeze as they luffed up to a close-hauled course.
- 8. GBR luffed up immediately after ARG luffed.
- 9. Contact occurred between the crew of ARG and the jib of GBR.
- 10. The contact did not cause damage or injury.
- 11. No penalty was taken.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 11, 14, 43.1(c)

- 1. GBR to windward failed to keep clear of ARG to leeward, and broke RRS 11.
- 2. GBR did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- ARG the right-of-way boat did not act to avoid contact with GBR, when it was reasonably possible. ARG broke RRS 14.
- Since ARG was the right-of way boat and the contact did not cause damage or injury, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(c), for breaking RRS 14.
