1. RULES

- 1.1. Each regatta will be governed by the “rules” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024. The prescriptions of the National Authority will not apply.
- 1.2. Rule 7 (a) of the ILCA class rules is restricted as follows:
“Only one person shall be on board whilst racing. The person shall be named on the entry form.”
- 1.3. Appendix P "Special Procedures for Rule 42" will apply with changes to include: allowing a jury initiated redress, points penalty for a first penalty given after finishing
- 1.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will prevail.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY PROCEDURE

- 4.1. **Registration** shall be made online <https://fragliavela.sailti.com/en/default/races/race/text/ILCAYOUTHEASTERMEETING2023-en> , before the 3rd of April. To complete registration it is compulsory to send by email at race@fragliavela.org all the requested documentation (boat insurance and for Italian sailors: class membership and FIV membership) prior 3rd of April.
- 4.2 Crew substitution of the registered sailor is not allowed.
- 4.3 Any sailor who has not completed the registration by the closing time for registration finalization, will be removed from the list of sailors of the event and will not be scored at that event.
- 4.4 **ILCA 6: Maximum 180.**
ILCA 4: Maximum 180.

Entries will be accepted by the first come – first served principle and payment is mandatory at the moment of entry. No entry can be completed without payment

5. ENTRY FEE

5.1 Entry fee, if paid before the 15th of March 23.59: 110€

Late entry fee, if paid from the 16th of March 00.00: 130 €

The entry fee shall be paid by **Paypal**. At the Club are NOT accepted payment by cash or credit card.

5.2 Cancellation policy: For registration annulation before the 15th of March the entry fee paid will be refund 90%. For notifications after the 16th of March and before the regatta registration 50% of the entry fee paid will be refunded. After the 3rd of April no entry fee will be refunded.

6. CREW LIMITATION

6.1. Age Eligibility:

- ILCA 6 Women: Overall, Women Under 21 (born 2003-2008), Women Under 19 (born 2005- 2008), Girls Under 17 (born 2007-2008)
- ILCA 6 Men: Overall, Boys Under 19 (born 2005-2008), Boys Under 17 (born 2007-2008),
- ILCA 4 Boys: Overall (born 2006-2011), Boys Under 16, (born 2008–2011)
- ILCA 4 Girls: Overall, Girls Under 16 (born 2008– 2011).

- Proof of age can be required at registration.

6.2 Athletes born in 2011, are allowed to race only after the day of their 12th birthday.

7. AVERTISING

7.1 The event is “free advertising” as per World Sailing regulation 20.

7.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

8. COMPETITION FORMAT

8.1 10 races are scheduled. Maximum 3 races per day are scheduled.

8.2 A fourth race can be sailed only when in delay with the program or when the forecast suggest that no race can be sailed in the next day. No more than one race can be raced in advance of the program.

8.3 Ilca 4 respectively will have separate starts from Ilca 6.

9. SCHEDULE

9.1 Event Schedule

Saturday, April 8 ^h	Races; Prize-giving at the end of the races

9.2 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 15.00.

10. MEASUREMENTS

10.1 Boat and equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules, wet clothing rules and sailing instructions at the discretion of the technical committee.

10.2 Inspection of the sails might be performed before the beginning of the event and before registration.

11. BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

11.1 All competitors shall use only one hull, sail, mast, boom, centreboard and rudder. The regatta will be sailed in Laser class boats as recognized by World Sailing, commonly sold under the brand name “ILCA” or “Laser”. All boats must have a valid World Sailing Plaque attached in accordance with the ILCA class rules to the aft face of the cockpit.

11.2 Sails shall have the full sail number and NATIONAL LETTERS in accordance with the Class Rules and the RRS. The national letters shall denote the National Authority of which the sailor is a member in accordance with RRS 75.2 and with the Notice of Race clause 4.1 Eligibility and Entry Regulations. This changes RRS Appendix G 1.1.

11.3 Women competitors shall place a red diamond on each side of their sail (back to back) in compliance with ILCA class rule 4(g).

12 VENUE

12.1 Attachment A shows the Club Area.

12.2 The intended race-course area will be in front of the Club. See Attachment B.

13 .RACE COURSES

Trapezoid courses will be used with inner and outer loops or windward leeward courses.

14. PROTESTS AND PENALTY SYSTEM

14.1 Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

14.2 Scoring penalties will be applied as specified in sailing instructions.

15. SCORING

12.1 Where a fleet is split into Gold and Silver groups, the 1st ranked in the silver fleet will be ranked in the subsequent place of the gold fleet; that concept is extended when we have more groups, bronze and emerald.

12.2 Where men and women fleets sail together (ILCA 6 and ILCA 4 Fleets) the men and women will be ranked separately by simply extracting the women's positions from the overall positions and rescored as 1st, 2nd, ... etc.

16. TEAM AND SUPPORT BOATS

Team and support boats shall, at all times when afloat, be conspicuously identified by the identification flag provided by the Organizing Authority. They must fill an accreditation form available online at this link:

17. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show at their discretion, any photographs, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation

18. LIABILITY

18.1 RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone". Therefore, the participants are aware that the sailing activity falls within those governed by Article 2050 of the Italian Civil Code and that all participants must have a valid FIV membership that guarantees accident coverage, including death and permanent disability

18.2 The sailing club, national authority, their officers, members and volunteers do not accept liability for loss of life or property, personal injury or damage caused by, or arising out of, the regattas.

18.3 The establishment of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a boat he or she is sailing.

18.4 A competitor shall maintain their boat in a safe and seaworthy condition

18.5 A competitor is wholly and exclusively responsible for third party liability insurance on the boat that he or she is sailing and for his or her personal accident and health insurance. Insurance requirements details for each regatta can be found in the regatta information below.

19. INSURANCE

19.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000 € per event or the equivalent. A proof of it shall be sent by email at race@fragliavela.org prior to 3rd April 2023.

19.2 Each competitor is wholly and exclusively responsible for third party liability insurance on the boat that he or she is

sailing and for his or her personal accident and health insurance.

19.3 Each competitor is wholly and exclusively responsible to maintain his boat in a safe and seaworthy condition checking it before going afloat.

20. PRIZES

21. SAFETY

Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times when afloat, except briefly when changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes rule RRS 40.

22. LOGISTIC INFORMATION

22.1. Boats trailers and cars may park in the sailing club parking lots from Monday, April 3rd until Sunday, April 9th. It is forbidden to park Camper, Vans, either during the day or overnight, within the limits of the Fraglia Vela Malcesine private area.

22.2 Please enter with the trailers from the North Entrance of the Club and not from the main entrance of the car park. We will publish the map of the logistic planning for the regatta.

22.3. For coach boats renting write at race@fragliavela.org

22.4 TRAINING AT FRAGLIA VELA MALCESINE:

Free hospitality at the Club from Monday 3rd of April to Sunday 9th of April.

Any competitor that plans to use the club facilities before 3rd April shall email race@fragliavela.org to book a slot. No boats will be allowed into the club outside of the event dates without a booking. There is a fee for bookings outside of the free days listed above. (Prices per boat: €15/day or €75/week)

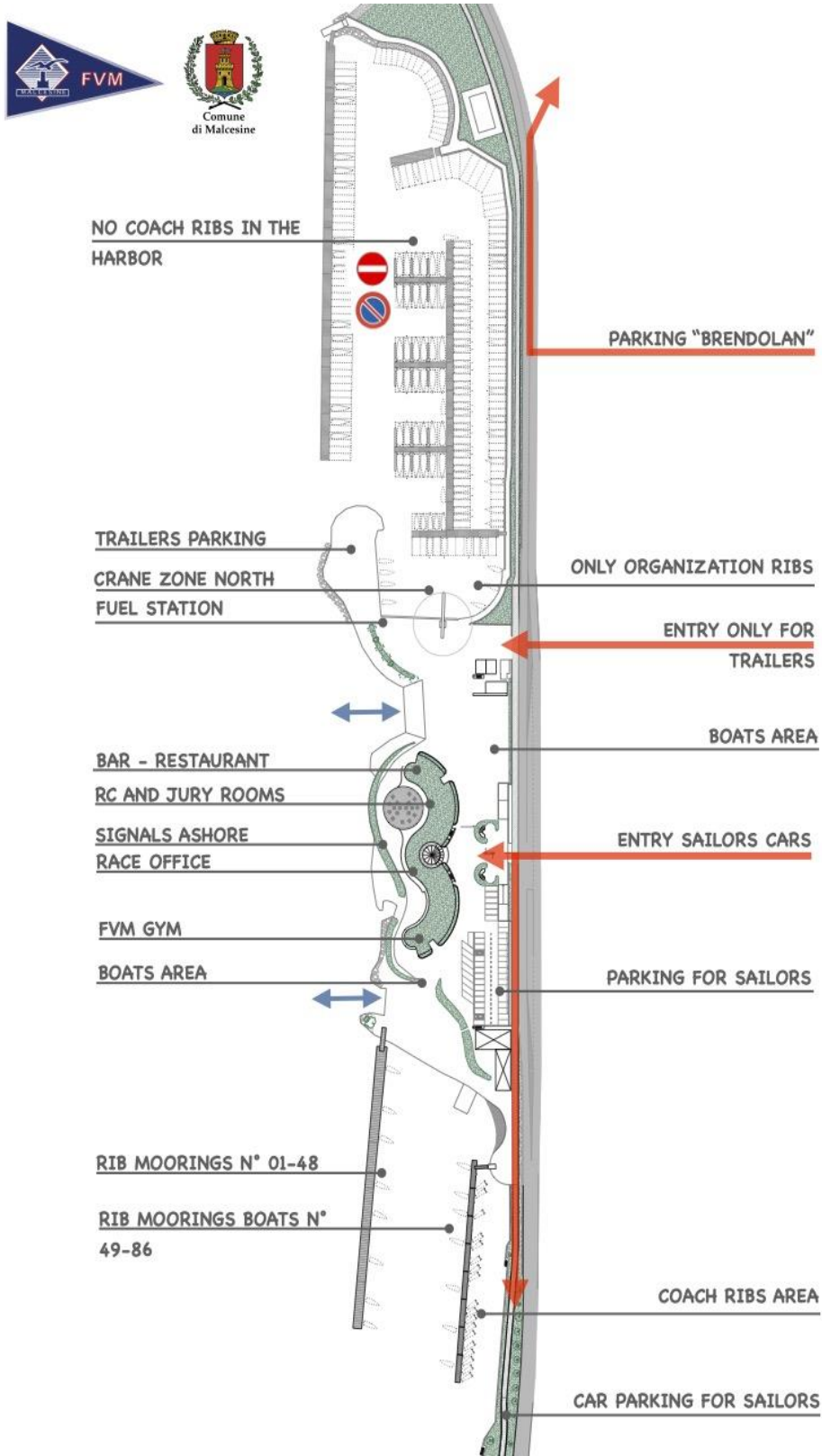
