PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. See state sloppy and wind 4 kn.
- 2. 254 and 6413 on a beat to mark 1 with 254 sailing on starboard tack and 6413 on port tack.
- 3. When 254 entered the zone she was fetching the mark.
- 4. 6413 passed head to wind ahead and half a boat width to windward of 254
- 5. When 6413 was on a clauses hauled course she was clear ahead of 254.
- 6. 254 bore away and established a leeward overlap at a minimum distance of 60cm.
- 7. Contact occurred beam to beam at a distance of less than new boat length to the mark.
- 8. 254 rouded the mark at a distance of 60cm and 60cm distance to 6413
- 9. No damage.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

 $\textbf{Rules:}\ 18.3,\ 43.1(b),\ 14$

- 1. After 6413 passed head to wind from port to starboard tack inside the zone and was then fetching the mark, she failed to give mark-room to 254 who was overlapped inside her. 6413 broke RRS 18.3.
- 2. 6413 to windward failed to keep clear of 254 to leeward, and broke RRS 11.
- 3. 6413 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 4. 254 the right-of-way boat, did not act to avoid contact with 6413 when it was reasonably possible. 254 broke RRS 14.
- 5. Since 254 was right-of way boat and the contact did not cause damage or injury, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(c) for breaking RRS 14.
