

NOTICE OF RACE – AMENDMENTS YACHTS and DAY SAILING BOATS

Thursday 25th August to Sunday 28th August 2022

Amendment 1 (Issued 24th January 2022)

NoR 1.3.2(a), replace "Short" by "Two" twice. In 1.3.2(d) replace the phrase starting "except" by "except in the Two Handed Class". In 1.3.2(e) replace "Short Handed class" by "Two Handed class" and delete "with no more than two crew".

NoR 4.3.1, in the table, replace the "IRC short handed" row by:

IRC Two	Boats holding an IRC 2022 certificate (or Short Handed certificate) and sailing with two crew***	IRC	Divisions subject to entries	IRC 2H

and add a third footnote:

*** Boats shall sail and comply with the same rating as their entry throughout the event.

Amendment 2 (Issued 5th June 2022)

Add NoR 12.5 as follows:

12.5 **Team trophies**

- 12.5.1 Subject to sufficient entries, two team trophies will be awarded, the Jubilee Vase Club Team and the Jubilee Vase Scratch Team. A boat will be eligible if it has entered the Series before 17:00 on 24th August. A boat may compete for both trophies, but within each trophy a boat may compete for only one team.
- 12.5.2 For the Club Team competition, a club team will comprise at least three and no more than five eligible boats competing in at least two classes or divisions. Clubs are invited to nominate their team(s) by email to entries@dartmouthsailingweek.com by 12:00 on 25th August, and may

- nominate up to 3 teams. Otherwise, one team per club will be created automatically, based on club membership as declared on the boat's Series entry form, and will comprise their first 5 boats in order of submitting their entries.
- 12.5.3 For the Scratch Team competition, a team will comprise any 3 boats competing in at least two classes or divisions, except that it may not comprise boats solely from one Club team. A team representative should, before 12:00 on 25th August, complete the Scratch Team entry form either via the online entry system, or using the downloadable form and returning it to RDYC or by email to entries@dartmouthsailingweek.com.
- 12.5.4 A boat's score will be calculated according to NoR 12.1, 12.2 and 12.3.2, multiplied by a Class/Division Weighting Factor (to recognise the added difficulty of achieving a particular position in a larger fleet). The Class/Division Weighting Factor for each boat will be: 10 divided by the square root of (N+17), where N is defined as the number of boats in her class/division (as at 17:00 on 24th August).
- 12.5.5 For the Club Team competition, the team's score will be the sum of its lowest three boat scores. For the Scratch Team competition, the team's score will be the sum of its three boat scores. For each competition, the winner will be the team with the lowest score, and in the event of a tie the trophy will be shared.

Amendment 3 (Issued 18th August 2022)

Add NoR 1.4.3 as follows:

1.4.3 The J/109 class Rules 2021 of the J/109 UK and Ireland Class Association shall apply to the J/109 class racing with the exception of clause 6.1 where the wording shall be deleted and replaced with the following:"Total crew numbers will be limited to the boats IRC certificate limit plus one."(Change at the request of the Class Association in compliance with RRS 87.)
