## 7. Description Of Incident

Under 1 minute from the start, we were on the committee boat end of the start line luffing before going down to build speed to accelerate for the start. Suddenly Misty Mountain came beneath us from astern , reaching with significant speed and established an overlap with their bowsprit roughly 1 meter to leeward of our port side pushpit. As soon as overlap was established, we turned up immediately to keep clear. Misty Mountain aggressively luffed and did not hail us or give us any warning for us to keep clear. They collided with us hitting our port pushpit with their hull behind the beam area. I was sitting on the leeward side on main trim position and Anne was sitting in the port pushpit. Suddenly without verbal warning we heard a crashing sound with splinters flying into our boat. I heard Anne scream

In fear but was luckily unhurt. We did not hear them hail us or tell us to head up before the collision.
