7. Description Of Incident

Boat "A" (Cheeky Cow) was on layline to the first weather mark of race #2. Boat "B" (Destroyer) was on port tack on port tack layline. At 4 boat lengths to the weather mark Boat A hailed "Don't do it!" and continued to hail until the boat B started to tack inside the 2 boat length zone. At that time collision was immanent and Boat A luff to avoid collision. Boat "B" continued to go to weather and prohibited Boat "A" from sailing proper course. We hailed to Boat "B" that they were infringing Boat "A" by trying to do there penalty turns and not letting Boat sail their proper course. Boat "A" Lost at east 3 minutes through no fault of our own. Boat "A" is seeking redress of 3 minutes.

In conclusion Boat "B" did not keep clear of other boats while doing there penalty turns. Boat "A" Does recognize that Boat "B" did do 2 penalty turns but did not do any other turns to absolve them selves by taking Boat "A" to almost head to wind.
