PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind speed approximately 12 kts. Sea state flat.
- 2. 131, 187 and 119 were all on starboard tack, running towards a leeward mark. 131 was the leeward boat. 187 was in the middle. 119 was the windward boat.
- 3. The three boats were overlapped for some time and less than 1 boat length apart, sailing the same course.
- 4. The three boats were going to pass the Race Committee boat (Not a mark on the course at that time) on their starboard
- 5. At approximately 2 boat lengths from the Race Committee boat, 131 hailed 187 twice for room to pass the Race Committee boat.
- 6. 187, in turn, hailed 119 for room for 131.
- 7. 119 did not change course.
- 8. There was contact between 131's port gunwhale and 187's starboard gunwhale. There was no damage.
- 9. No boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: 14, 19.2(b)

- 1. 119 did not give room to 187 to comply with her obligation to give room to 131. 119 broke RRS 19.2(b)
- 2. 187 did not give room to 131. 187 broke RRS 19.2(b) and RRS 14 but is exonerated under RRS 43.1
- 3. 131 broke RRS 14 but is exonerated under RRS 43.1

119 is to be scored DSQ in race 6.
