## **NOTICE OF RACE**

The Organising Authority (OA) is Army Yachting Node (AYN) Mumbai under the aegis of Yachting Association of India (YAI).

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2021-2024).
- 1.2 National authority prescriptions if any will apply.
- 1.3 In all rules governing this event, the notations.
  - 1.3.1 [DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the Jury/Protest Committee and may be less than a disqualification.
  - 1.3.2 [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee or technical committee without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1, A4 and A5.1.
  - 1.3.3 [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.5 The Equipment Rules of Sailing and current class rules of the competing classes will apply.
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between a rule in the Notice of Race and a rule in the Sailing Instructions, the rule in the Sailing Instructions will take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7.

1.7 **[DP][NP]** In addition to COVID-19 safety measures placed at **Appendix 'A'**, All prevailing central and state Government's SOP and protocols with regards to COVID-19 shall strictly be adhered to by all personnel. All such instructions will be prominently displayed on the Notice Board. All competitors and support personnel arriving to the venue from other states will be required to carry a COVID-19 negative certificate taken as per relevant rules at the time of entry into Mumbai and as applicable to the State of Maharashtra.

#### 2 [DP][NP] EVENT ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.
- 2.2 **[DP][NP]** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.
- 2.3 All competitors and their support team automatically grant the OA and any event sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show at their discretion, any photographs, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation. Competitors may be required for media interviews during the period of the event.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The event is open to the following classes of boats:-

- 3.2 A minimum of five participating boats in a class will be required for the series to be constituted for that class except Windfoiling (iQFoil) (Men & Women), Kiteboarding (Men & Women), 49er FX (Women), RS:X (Women) and Nacra17 (Mixed).
- 3.3 Eligible boats are to enter by completing the Entry Form attached (**Appendix 'C'**) and emailing it to <a href="mailto:sailindia@gmail.com">sailindia@gmail.com</a> by 25 Nov 2021 along with details of entry fees paid in the account mentioned in para 5.2. Late entries may be accepted only at the discretion of the OA upon payment of additional late fee of Rs 2500/-.
- 3.4 All participants and representing Clubs are required to be Life Member/ Annual Associate Member of YAI. Original membership card to be produced at the time of registration, failing which, entries will not be accepted.
- 3.5 All participants are required to get their own boats for the event. No boats will be provided by the OA.

- 3.6 Competitors and their support team shall complete an on-site registration at the Regatta Office. Each team shall be accompanied by the team leader, who may complete the registration on behalf of the team with all necessary documents. The on-site registration of each competitor will not be completed until the measurement form issued by the Technical Committee has been submitted to the Regatta Office.
- 3.7 All associated clubs/ teams participating in the event are required to carry their club burgee (Size 12 x 18 inches) and submit to the regatta office at the time of registration.
- 3.8 All competitors shall bring their own personal floatation devices (Min AUS PDF II or above) which must be capable of being fastened or secured at all times while afloat. Wet suits, dry suitsand trapeze harnesses are not personal floatation devices. The organizing authority reserves the right to reject any personal floatation devices which it considers unsuitable. Personal floatation devices shall comply with appropriate international standards.

#### 4 RANKING

4.1 The event is a YAI approved Ranking Regatta event for all classes.

#### 5 FEES

5.1 The following fees shall be paid as per NOR 3.1 to complete the entry:-

- 5.3 Entry Fees shall be free of bank commissions. Any bank fee will be charged to the competitors.
- 5.4 Entries may not be accepted on or after 08 Dec 2021.
- 5.5 Entry fees once paid will not be refundable.
- 5.6 Payment details and invoice shall be provided to entrants upon receipt of the entry form.

#### 6 FORMAT

6.1 The competition will consist of a single series of fleet races for all sailing events.

#### 7 SCHEDULE

- 7.2 12 races are scheduled for all other classes except that 15 races are scheduled for 49er, 49erFX and Nacra 17 (Mix) events.
- 7.3 Maximum of 4 races per class per day may be scheduled.
- 7.4 On the last scheduled day of racing (15 Dec 2021), no warning signal will be made after 1400h.

#### 8 [DP] MEASUREMENTS AND EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 Measurement certificates are required for the 470 class of boats.
- 8.2 Only class legal hull, sails, spars and foils are allowed to be used for the event.
- 8.3 Boats may be subject to inspection at any time during the event.
- 8.4 **[DP]** Change of damaged or lost equipment will be allowed only after the approval of technical committee. Such request shall be made to the technical committee at the first reasonable opportunity by filling in a relevant form at the race office. The change of equipment may only be permitted after the technical committee has checked and scrutinized both the damaged and the substituting equipment.
- 8.5 **[DP]** If any change of equipment was made on water before or between races, both damaged and equipment substituted shall be presented to the technical committee after the end of the day's racing. Repairs or replacements required afloat may be approved after the race provided that either the race committee or the technical committee afloat is notified before the next race.

#### 8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available after completion of registration on 09 Dec 21.

#### 10 VENUE

- 10.1 The competition venue will be southern end of Girgaum Chowpatty, Mumbai.
- 10.2 The racing area will be the waters in front of competition venue. **Appendix 'B'** shows the location of the racing areas.
- 10.3 The venue will be open for all competitors from 02 Dec 2021.

#### 11 THE COURE

11.1.1 The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward, Trapezoid, or any other configuration as may be described in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 12 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 12.1 RRS Appendix P will apply as changed by NoR 12.2.
- 12.1.1 For the Men's and Women's Skiffs, RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

#### 13 SCORING

- 13.1 The low point system of RRS Appendix 'A' will apply.
- 13.2 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 13.3 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 13.3.1 When 6 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 13.3.2 When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

#### 14 [DP][NP] SUPPORT VESSELS

- 14.1.1 All support vessels are to stay at least 100m outside the racing area from the time of the first preparatory signal for the first class to start till completion of race. Support vessels are to maintain a speed of 5 knots or less, unless otherwise required, when races are on going.
- 14.1.2 Support vessels will be marked with their club insignia and need to maintain less than 5 knots speed at all times in the vicinity of the racing area.
- 14.1.3 Personnel on board support vessels are required to wear a life jacket / personal floatation device whilst on water and to be a certified Power Boat Handling Certificate holder from YAI.

#### 15 [DP][NP] BERTHING

15.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

#### 16 [DP][NP] RADIO COMMUNICATION

16.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

#### 17 PRIZES

- 17.1 Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the competitor's ranked top three at each event respectively.
- 17.2 If the numbers of boats in 49er FX & Nacra 17 are three or less than three, then only one medal shall be given.
- 17.3 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

#### 18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

18.1 Competitors participate in the competition entirely at their own risk. Refer RRS 3, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority or any other race officials and volunteers, will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the competition.

#### 19 [DP][NP] MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- By participating in this competition, competitors and their support team automatically grant to the Organising Authority and any event sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use, and show at their discretion, any photographs, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue, or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
- Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organising Authority. Information from such equipment shall not be used by a boat as evidence in a hearing. This changes RRS 63.6.
- 19.3 Competitors may be required for media interviews during the period of the competition.

#### 20 FURTHER INFORMATION

#### 21 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 21.1 Team members and officials shall observe the regulations of the host club and shall always behave correctly and follow all COVID protocols as applicable by local administration.
- 21.2 Unbecoming conduct at any time, whether on shore or afloat; with or without any damage to the facilities, may be investigated by the Jury/ Protest Committee who may call a hearing and impose a scoring penalty/ removal of person from regatta site.


#### **COVID - 19 SAFETY MEASURES**

The Standard Operating Procedure will be in force during Sail India 2021 (YAI Ranking Regatta) to provide asafe environment for officials and competitors during the ongoing pandemic.

- 1. All sailors, support staff and officials shall maintain social distance and hygiene throughout the event and have to provide RTPCR COVID negative report on arrival in Mumbai.
- 2. All participants will be thermally screened at the entrance. Entry will be permitted only to the individuals with normal body temperature.
- 3. Only one access point will be open for entry and exit for competitors and staff/officials/coaches.
- 4. All personnel entering the venue must be in possession of face mask, covering their nose and mouth properly. Participants found not wearing face mask will be liable to get penalized on that particular day.
- 5. Handshake and other forms of greetings which need physical contact are to be avoided.
- 6. Not more than four personnel are to be allowed to enter washroom and toilets at the same time.
- 7. All participants are responsible to handle his/ her sail boat and trolley during launch/ recovery.
- 8. All boats are to cast off / came alongside in a staggered manner to avoid conjunction of boats and personnel. All team coaches/ reps are to ensure that their power boat/sail boats are parked at their designated places only.
