## 7. Description Of Incident

We were on starboard calling "starboard" for an extended period of time. 7607 did not alter their course and continued to sail towards us. We attempted to avoid contact, altering our course but were unable to avoid and they collided into the port side of our boat. The collision occurred while our crew was on trapeze, and the force of the hit cause our boat to tack, dumping & trapping our crew between the shroud and the boom. We immediately hailed protest and 7607 did a 720. We attempted to continue to sail but our port gunwhale filled with water throughout the race. We discovered that the source of the water was a crack through the side of our hull caused by 7607 colliding with us. As our gunwhale was filling with water, we were forced to retire after the first race and were not able to sail for the rest of the day. Our boat requires a significant fibreglass repair.

# 8. Damage Or Injury

Our port gunwhale is cracked through at the bow of our boat. It will require a significant repair.
