7. Description Of Incident

Race committee should have enforced rule 32.1(d) but did not.

32.1: After the starting signal, the race committee may shorten or abandon the race

32.1(d) for any other reason directly affecting the safety or fairness of the competition.

It was immediately clear soon after starting that the RC sent PHRF D class on too long of a course (course D, 6.1 miles) to complete within the time limit. Class PHRF D was the only class with no finishers. Classes starting after PHRF D were sent on 4.1 mile or 3.1 mile courses. Since the Sunset Series is an inter-class series with several classes competing for overall racing division placings, this put PHRF D at a disadvantage to the other racing division classes.
