PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

After about half the fleet had finished, the bows of the two large RC finish line vessels came into contact, and it was no longer possible to sail between them.

TUR 88 was the fist boat unable to sail between the two vessels.

The finish line was between flagpoles mounted on the stern of the vessels, and TUR 88 had crossed the line before becoming unable to pass between the vessels.

Thereafter the RC gave boats finishing positions on the basis of the order they crossed the extension of a line outside the two vessels

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: 62.1

Preventing boats from sailing between the two finish line vessels was an improper action of the RC.

TUR 88's finishing position was not made worse as a result of this action.
