NOTICE OF RACE

1. **RULES.**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS).

1.2 In all rules governing this event, the notations;

1.2.1 [DP] in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1.2.2 [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee or technical committee without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.

1.2.3 [NP] denotes a rule for which a breach of that rule shall not be grounds for protests by another boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1.3 The Equipment Rules of Sailing and current class rules of the competing classes will apply.

1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

1.5 Appendix P will apply.

1.6 [DP][NP] Protocols relating to COVID 19 may be published at any time and will have the status of a rule.

2. **ADVERTISING.** Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

3. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY.**

3.1 The event will be sailed in the following classes.

(a) ILCA 4 (Boys & Girls). ILCA 4 shall be under 18 yrs (the age the competitor becomes in the year of the championship). **RANKING**

(b) Optimist Class (Boys & Girls). Optimist class shall be under 15yrs (the age the competitor becomes in the year of the championship). **RANKING**

(c) 29er (under 19 yrs, the age the competitor becomes in the year of the championship). **RANKING**

(d) 420 Class (Mixed Youth, under 19 yrs, the age the competitor becomes in the year of the championship). **RANKING**

(e) 420 Class (Open).

(g) ILCA 7 (Men).

(h) ILCA 6 (Open).

(i) Wind Surfing & Kite Boarding (all types) for DEMO racing.

3.2 This event is a National Ranking Event for ILCA 4, Optimist, 29er and 420 class (mixed youth). Five participating boats in class will be required for the series to be constituted for all the classes, except 29er, 420 Class (Mixed youth) wherein three participating boats in class will be required. No limit/ restrictions on non-ranking classes.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter by sending the attached form (addendum A) to directorregatta24@gmail.com. Entry forms can also be submitted on **UDAY FOR SAILORS ANDROID APP.** (Available on Google Play Store). Entry Forms submission/Registration on App will provide a discount of Rs 500/-. Entry fee may be paid at the time of registration in Regatta Office.

3.4 Each sailor of ILCA 4, 420 Youth & Optimist class, or any other sailor under 18 yrs of age, shall submit a signed guardian consent form, attached as addendum B. For the duration of the championship each ILCA 4, 420 Youth & Optimist class sailor shall be accompanied by a

responsible adult who is named on the parent/guardian consent form. All competitors irrespective of age must fill the **Indemnity Bond** provided at the end of this NOR, as addendum C.

3.5 All participants and representing clubs are required to be life members/ annual associate members/ affiliated to YAI. Proof of membership are to be produced at the time of registration, failing which, entries will not be accepted. As per YAI Policy, participants for RANKING events must have Basic Level 3 Certification from YAI.

3.6 Competitors and their support teams shall complete an on-site registration at the Race Office. Each team shall be accompanied by the team leader, who may complete the registration on behalf of the team with all necessary documents. The on-site registration of each competitor will not be complete until the measurement form issued by the Technical Committee has been submitted to the Race Office.

3.7 Each competitor can participate only in one event.

3.8 The entry closing date is **01 Apr 2024**.

3.9 Entry fees will not be refunded under any circumstance unless the entry is not accepted.

4. **FEES.**

4.1 The Entry Fee will be as follows:-

(a) Single hander entry	-	7000 INR
(b) Double hander entry	-	10000 INR
(c) Fee for registration of Coaches/Team Managers	-	4000 INR
(d) Parents may also register if wish to avail facilities	-	3500 INR

Note: **50% Entry Fees Concession will be provided for Female participants.**

4.2 The Administration Charges for Lodging/Boarding & local conveyance if staying under arrangements of OA, (NOT APPLICABLE IF STAYING UNDER OWN ARRANGEMENTS) for Participants, Coaches/Team Managers, Support Staff or any other person accompanying the Team, will be 400 INR per head per day. Suitable accommodation, neat & clean stay and MESSING facility is being catered by the OA. Centralized & Pooled local conveyance also being organized by OA.

4.3 Refreshments/Lunches will be provided by OA on Sailing races days.

4.4 Entry fee includes attendance for select functions / ceremonies and certificates as applicable.

4.5 Administration Charges include boarding/lodging & local conveyance provided by OA.

4.6 Amount equal to **Sleeper class Rail fare** (including return journey), **will be refunded** for all Sailors under age of **19 yrs**, on producing the ticket, irrespective of mode of travel.

5. **FORMAT.** All classes will sail a single series of fleet races.

6 **SCHEDULE.**

6.1 The initial Competitors Briefing will be held at 0900 h on 01 Apr 2024 at UMIAM SAILING CLUB at the Orchid Resorts Water Sports Complex, Umiam, Shillong.

6.2 The Event Schedule is as follows:-

6.3 A total of 10 races per class are scheduled. Each class is scheduled to sail three (03) races per day, but may sail one additional race per day.

6.4 No warning signal will be made after 1200hr on 06 Apr 2024.

6.5 Any changes in NOR will be intimated to all clubs/associations and also will be posted on the official notice board.

7. **MEASUREMENTS.**

7.1 Measurement certificates are required for Optimist & 420 classes of boats.

7.2 Only class legal hulls, sails, spars and foils are allowed to be used for the event.

7.3 Boats may be subject to inspection at any time during the event.

7.4 [DP] Change of damaged or lost equipment will be allowed only after the approval of Technical Committee. Such requests shall be made to the Technical Committee at the first reasonable opportunity by filling of a relevant form kept at the Race Office. The change of equipment may only be permitted after the Technical Committee has checked and scrutinized both the damaged and the substitute equipment.

7.5 [DP] If any change of equipment is made on water before or between races, both damaged and equipment substituted shall be presented to the Technical Committee after the end of the day's racing. Repairs or replacements required afloat may be approved after the race provided that either the Race Committee or the Technical Committee afloat is notified before the next race.

8. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.**

8.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available after completion of registration on 01 Apr 2024 at Venue.

9. **VENUE.**

9.1 The venue for the event will be UMIAM SAILING CLUB, at ORCHID Lake Resorts, Water Sports Complex, Umiam Lake, Shillong, Meghalaya State.

10. **COURSES.**

10.1 The Courses will be Triangular & Windward/Leeward or any other course as described in the sailing instructions.

11. **PENALTY SYSTEM.**

11.1 Appendix 'P' will apply.

12. **SCORING.**

12.1 Scoring will be as under.

(a) Five (05) races are required to be completed to constitute a series for all categories.

(b) When Seven (07) have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her WORST score.

(c) When Eight to Ten (08-10) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her TWO WORST scores.

13. **SUPPORT BOATS [DP].**

13.1 All support vessels are to stay at least 100m outside the racing area from the time of the first preparatory signal for the first class to start till the completion of all races. Support vessels are to maintain a speed of 5 knots or less, unless otherwise required, when races are ongoing.

13.2 Support vessels will be marked with their club insignia.

13.3 Personnel onboard support vessels are required to wear a life jacket / personal floatation device and carry a functional VHF radio whilst on water.

13.4 The engine safety cut out switch and tether (kill chord) shall be securely attached to the driver at all times when the engine is running. As per YAI Policy, all Coaches/ support Boat operators must have Power Boat handling Certification from YAI, for purpose of operating a Motor boat at Venue.

14. **BERTHING [DP] [NP]**

14.1 Boats will be kept in the assigned places while they are in the boat park.

15. **RADIO COMMUNICATION [DP] [NP].**

15.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16. **PRIZES.**

16.1 The winner in each class will be awarded:

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16.2 Additional prizes may be awarded by OA in different depending upon the entries.

17. **BOATS.**

17.1 Participants are required to bring their own boats and equipment.

17.2 Any Club/Team desirous of entering at least **06 (SIX) Boats**, will be provided **SUBSIDY (upto 50%) in transportation** of boats in Truck/Container, To & Fro Venue. Further information may be obtained from OA well in advance.

17.2 Few boats of each class are available on charter and may be provided by OA. OA may be approached for the same.

18. **BPHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT.**

18.1 By entering the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority the right in perpetuity to make, use, and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped, or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

19. **LIABILITY and INDEMNIFICATION**

19.1 The OA and all their officers, members, race officials and volunteers do not accept liability for loss of life or property, or personal injury or damage caused by or arising out of the event. Competitors take part in the event at their own risk (See RRS Rule 3, Decision to Race). **Respective sailing clubs need to ascertain sailing proficiency of their sailors,** as advised by YAI from time to time.

19.2 The establishment of the notice of race and the sailing instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of competitors being solely and entirely responsible for the management of their boats before, during and after the championship.

19.3 Competitors shall maintain their boats in a safe and seaworthy condition.

19.4 A competitor shall be of good health and a competent sailor capable of racing a dinghy/skiff/windsurfing board (as applicable) in open waters in all conditions, including strong winds.

19.5 At-fault occurrences to other boats are the responsibility of the competitor. Competitors are not covered by any liability insurance provided by the organizing authority and should provide their own coverage for personal goods and liability protection. The organizing authority recommends that competitors consult their own insurance carriers to ensure they are covered at this event and regarding additional personal liability insurance coverage.

19.6 A competitor is advised to have personal accident and health insurance that covers him while attending the event and while racing.

19.7 To the fullest extent permitted by law, each competitor agrees to indemnify and hold, the host, YAI, owners, affiliates, officers, employees, agents, members, volunteers, committee persons and race officials, acting in their official capacities, harmless from any claim arising from a competitor's acts or omissions.

21 **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.**

20.1 Weather during the Regatta is likely to be moderately cold during mornings & nights while days are expected to be sunny/mild rain showers and pleasant.

20.2 Temperature may range from average 15 to 25 degree Celsius.

20.3 Shillong City is a Tourist Destination approx 25 kms away from Venue, other Tourist places, Cherapunjee & Dawky each are within 6-8 hours turn around distance from Venue, participants may like to visit Tourist places before or after the Regatta under own arrangements. However, a two day centrally organized Tour is planned for early comers, see Para 6.2 above.

20.4 Shillong Airport is well connected with Kolkata and other Eastern States, which is approx. 15 min driving distance from Venue.

20.5 Guwahati is nearest Railhead & major Airport, which is about 100 kms (approx. 2hrs & 30 min driving time from Venue).

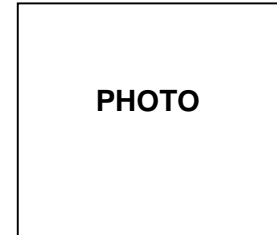
