PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1. Hearing No. 1 was heard together with hearing No. 2 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind speed was 11 knots.
- 2. Approaching mark 5, POL 10 and AUT 97 were sailing on starboard tack.
- 3. POL 10 entered the zone clear ahead and 1m to windward of AUT 97.
- 4. When at the mark, POL 10 lifted her kite and gybed to port tack
- 5. Less than five seconds after POL 10 had lifted her kite, and when POL 10 was already on port tack, AUT 97 established a leeward overlap with POL 10.
- 6. Less than one second later, contact occurred between POL 10's and AUT 97's bodies and foils, with no tangle.
- 7. The contact caused damage to POL 10's wetsuit (2cm cut on the leg) and a bruise to AUT 97's right arm.
- 8. At the moment of the incident, POL 10 and AUT 97 were around the 11th position.
- 9. A few kiteboards overtook them while they were recovering.
- 10. POL 10 finished race 6 in the 15th position and AUT 97 in the 17th position.
- 11. Neither kiteboard took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 10, 14, 43.1(b), 62.1, 63.2 and F2.18.2(a)(2)

- 1. AUT 97 not overlapped with POL 10 and not in the zone at the time POL 10 reached the zone, failed to give POL 10 mark-room, and broke RRS F2.18.2(a)(2).
- 2. AUT 97 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. POL 10 on port tack failed to keep clear of AUT 97 on starboard tack, and broke RRS 10.
- 4. Since POL 10 broke RRS 10 while she was sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(b) for this breach.
- 5. It was not reasonably possible for POL 10, the kiteboard sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled, to avoid contact with AUT 97 when it was clear that AUT 97 was not giving mark-room. POL 10 did not break RRS 14.
- 6. POL 10's score in race 6 was made significantly worse through recovering, not through physical damage. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.

7. AUT 97's score in race 6 was made significantly worse through her own fault. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.
