7. Description Of Incident

Request for Redress based on improper omission by the race Comittee.

I was sailing upwind on port with a speed of approximately 21 knots, just before approaching the starboard layline in 6/7th position, when my foil hit a very small mark ancored (see from the video) just above the waterline which I was not able to see in actual conditions. Given the Speed our boards are sailing, it is indispensable for our safety and fairness that the race comittee checks the racing area for potential hazards in particular if they are not or very limited visible for competitors.

By not checking the race area for limited obstructions before starting a race and this causing my board hitting an obstruction that was not visible for me, the race comittee made an omission that made my results worse without fault of my own. My Foil was broken and my knee injured and I was not able to continue the race. I therefore request redress for race Q6 in accordance with RRS 62.1(a).
