1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Sailing Racing Regulations. (RRV)
- 1.2 The official language will be Spanish. In the event of a conflict between languages, the English text will prevail.

2 COMUNICATIONS

- **2.1** The official notice board is located at https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/documents/7603/event
- **2.2** [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat will not make voice or data transmissions, nor receive voice or data communications that are not available to all boats and boards.

3 ADVERTISING

3.1 Boats will be required to display advertising provided by the organizing authority.

4 RACING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Sailing instructions will be available on the organization's website https://www.mayanwindfest.com/sailing.

5 ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

- 5.1 The regatta is open to all boats and boards of the Optimist, ILCA 4.7, ILCA 6, ILCA 7, Techno 293, iQFoil, Windsurfer LT and Kitefoil classes that formalize their registration and cover the corresponding fee, and that are up to date in their obligations to their national authority and class association.
- 5.2 Eligible boats and boards must register online no later than January 5, 2024 by filling out the electronic form available at https://www.mayanwindfest.com/register
- 5.3 In the case of Optimist and ILCA*, the registration deadline to have boat transportation included is December 15, 2023. (National competitors only)
 *Restrictions apply
- 5.4 Late registrations will only be accepted at the discretion of the organizing authority, covering the corresponding additional fee.

6 REGISTRATION FEES

7.1 They are programmed:

- 9 tests for Optimist, ILCA, Techno 293 and Windsurfer LT. Up to a maximum of 4 tests per day may be run.
- 12 tests for iQFoil and KiteFoil. Up to a maximum of 5 tests per day may be run.
- Team Race (Thursday or Saturday) for the advanced Optimist class. The team event (10-15 years old), the same athletes registered in the individual event will participate, it will not be mandatory to include athletes from both branches and one or more teams may be registered per club.





















8 VENUE

8.1 The venue will be Club de Playa Puerto Cancún located at:

Club de Playa Puerto Cancún Kukulcan Boulevard, Zona Hotelera 77500, Cancún, Quintana Roo

9 COURSES

9.1 The Instructions document show the courses including the approximate angles between the sections, the order in which the markers must be left and the side on which each marker must be left.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Optimist and ILCA classes:
 - a) At least 1 test must be carried out for the series to be valid.
 - b) If less than 6 races have been completed, the boat's series score will be the total of its race scores.
 - c) If 6 to 9 tests have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.
- 10.2 For iQFoil y Kitefoil classes:
 - a) At least 1 test must be carried out for the series to be valid.
 - b) When less than 3 tests have been completed, the boards score will be the total of its race scores.
 - c) When between 3 and 7 tests have been completed, the board score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.
 - d) When between 8 and 12 tests have been completed, score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst 2 score.
- 10.3 For Windsurfer LT y Techno 293 classes:
 - a) At least 1 test must be carried out for the series to be valid.
 - b) When less than 5 tests have been completed, the boards score will be the total of its race scores.
 - c) When more than 5 tests have been completed, the board score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.

11 MOORING AND STORAGE

11.1 While on land, boats will only be in the places assigned to them by the organizing committee.

12 SUPPORT VESSELS

12.1 Support and trainer boats must carry on board: personal flotation device, VHF radio in good working order, ropes and anchors of the appropriate size.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat will not make radio transmissions while racing, nor receive radio communications that are not available to all boats, this restriction includes mobile phones.





















14 PRIZES

14.1 The first three places in each class and category will be awarded according to the following table with a minimum of 5 boats registered. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.
