





Joining Instructions (Dinghies & MFOBs) MERSEA WEEK 2023 Sunday 13th to Friday 18th August 2023

Dear Competitor

Welcome to Mersea Week 2023.

Please take time to read this.

To all of you whether this is your first time at West Mersea, a regular visitor, or a local please come forward and ask us if you want to know something. We will do our best to answer all the questions we can.

The Mersea Week committee have introduced a number of changes to the week and these Joining Instructions are intended to help everyone through some of those changes. A few of these changes are intended to reduce our environmental impact (through less printing and no packs for dinghies and MFOBs) some are intended to move functions and process on line (Racing rules of sailing) and some are to encourage overall rules adherence (changes to rule 44). We will be using a number of apps and the QR codes for use on your handheld devices, these will be available at Registration. They are also at the end of this document. At the competitor briefing details (see section 7) we will explain how they are used. It would be helpful if at least one member of the crew of each boat attended.

For those who have visited us before you will know that West Mersea is in places very quirky. A further aim of this document is to give you all as much information upfront as possible so please take the time to read the notes below.

1. How to access West Mersea? (for Visitors)

The recommended method for getting around is on foot or by bike as there is limited parking. We operate a preferred route to the clubs, and we would appreciate if everybody followed the route suggested below.

DO NOT follow your GPS to the clubs. It will take you down a narrow road which is too narrow for your road trailer, and is currently closed at the lower end of the road, with NO turning space.

On crossing the Strood to access Mersea Island, please bear right at the "Y" junction and follow the signs for West Mersea (B1025).

Once in Mersea itself, please follow the road round into Mill Road and then again into Barfield Road. In practice, although the map shows these as a left turn followed by a right turn, you just need to continue to drive until you eventually end up in the High Street.

At the bottom of the High Street, the road will bear right past the Church, on your right is the White Hart pub, and then right again. At this stage, you will be on Coast Road and will be able to see the water on your left. Continue driving along Coast Road as far as you can go. You will pass the DSC dinghy park on your left just after the access road

to the hammerhead. Please stop and unload you boats into the dinghy park. We will endeavour to have some people around for help and advice. Be aware that there are yellow lines and the restrictions start on 1st April so move quickly.


Please do not park your car or trailer in the dinghy park as this will restrict your fellow sailors. Whatever you do please do not proceed with your car and trailer past the dinghy park, there is no place to turnaround.

If you can give us advanced notice we will endeavour to have some local helpers to advise you how and where to go on arrival. Everyone is a volunteer and please follow their instructions. The instructions are usually based upon experience, and we know the parking police are very active....

2. RNLI Lifeboat Station

Please note that between the various dinghy parks is an RNLI lifeboat station whose vehicular access is also along Coast Road. At all times, competitors must ensure that their vehicles, trailers and dinghies do not block access to the lifeboat station or Coast Road.

In the event that you hear a loud paging noise from the station, please make sure the road and lifeboat station access are clear. Do not park your boat on or in front of the lifeboat slip. These signals indicate that the lifeboat crews have been called out in response to an emergency. Please be extra vigilant at this time, as crew vehicles will be driving towards the Lifeboat Station quickly in response to being called out.



3. Trailers

Once you have unloaded your boat, please remove the road trailer/road base to your accommodation.

4. Car Parking Restrictions

Parking in West Mersea is difficult and limited. All along Coast Road there are yellow line parking restrictions in place. These car parking restrictions are in place effective 1st April. There are car parks in front of West Mersea Yacht club. A daily fee is payable. Please do not park in West Mersea Yacht Club car parks unless you are a member. You will need to use local car parks.

5. Sponsor Partners

6. Tally on and off

We will be using Two WhatsApp channels to communicate Race information and Tally information the QR codes for which are at the end of these instructions. These channels are not for general discussion. The process is as follows and will be repeated in the competitor briefing.

About 15 minutes before the Delta Flag is displayed, (more later) a WhatsApp goes out on the Tally WhatsApp stating Tally is open. Competitors can then Tally using your phone and have time to put the phone in a locker or safe location. If you do not have a suitable phone we have upstairs in the DSC Race box a tally PC.

The only required information is Sail number Persons on Board OUT (the word)

Approximately 15 minutes after Tally opens, "Delta flag" will be displayed on the WMYC mainmast. This tells everyone that the safety fleet is active, we are hoping to race and please head for the course area.

When you get back. Maximum 10 minutes after you arrive back on your mooring or ashore you should Tally in on the WhatsApp.

The only required information is Sail number
Persons on Board
IN (the word)

Failure to complete this in the ten minutes incurs a scoring penalty of 5 points added to the net score for the week for each offence. See the sailing instructions.

The **Competitor Information WhatsApp** is used by the Race team to communicate with the competitors, giving them new information during the day. It is used to communicate intentions and is not the ONB. It is especially used when we have postponements due to weather conditions. It should not be used for any other discussions.

7. Registration and Competitor briefing

The important links to the event are given below including the WhatsApp links. The West Mersea Yacht club is broadly opposite the hammerhead. Dabchicks Sailing club will be found at the end of Coast Road as far as you can go.

All competitors must Register. Failure to register will be scored as DNC.

The Registration times and location of Registration are given below.

Sailing Instructions, daily schedules, classes/fleets will be placed on the ONB by Wednesday, however it is safe to assume no dinghy races/MFOB races will take place before Noon on Sunday.

8. Food & Drink

Dabchicks sailing club.

Opens at 0830 for a full cooked breakfast through to around 1100 hrs.

The Bar will open at noon through to around 2300hrs.

West Mersea Yacht club

Bar and food from Noon, food served until 2030 hrs, Bar closes 2300 hrs

9. Changing Rooms, Toilets and Showers.

Changing facilities are available in the following locations:

Male, at the Dabchicks Sailing Club and West Mersea Yacht Club

Female, at the Dabchicks Sailing Club and West Mersea Yacht Club

There are lockers available in the changing room of the DSC.

Please do not leave valuables in any of the changing rooms except in the lockers.

10. RIBs

It maybe you wish to bring your own Rib, this is possible, but we must know in advance. You will need to launch from your road trailer down a slipway. Please be aware that there are no visitor moorings. We can allow some boats to raft up on our moorings, but this will be at your own risk and be directed by the Event Organiser.

11. Food in Mersea
