
Title: Notice of Race Amendment #2 Sailing Instructions Amendment #1

The point NoR 1.10 is deleted.

The point SI 1.13 is added as follow: If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race (NoR) and these SIs, the SIs will take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7.

The point SI 4.3 is changed as follow: The warning signals will be made not less than 60 minutes after flag D is displayed or not before the scheduled time, whichever is later. 'Boats shall not splash until this signal is made'.

The point SI 9.1 is changed as follow: The Courses W2, O2 and T2 are changed as follow:







The point SI 13.1 is changed as follow The finish line will be between two staffs displaying an orange flag and Blue Flag on the Race Committee vessels or between a staff on a race committee vessel and the course side of the finishing mark. This Changes Race Signals.

The point SI 15.3 is changed as follow: The time limit for the first boat to finish the race shall be 90min. Any boat finishing more than 30 minutes after the first boat finishes or failing to finish within 2 hours from the start, whichever is shorter shall be scored Did Not Finish (DNF). This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

The point SI 17.1 is changed as follow Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

(a) When fewer than 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 7 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

The point SI 18.2 is changed as follow:(NP)(SP) A boat that retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible. A boat that retires from a race and come ashore to make a repair and has an intent to return to the race area shall notify the Race Office as soon as arrived ashore and just before leave to the race area again.

The point SI 18.3 is added as follow: (NP)(SP)Check-out and check-in:

a. Before leaving to race on each scheduled racing day, a crew shall personally sign out on the required form located next to the Ramp

b. Within the protest time limit after returning ashore, a crew shall personally sign in on the required form located next to the Ramp.
