- 1. The hearing was held under Appendix UF after signalling that umpires do not have the facts required to make a decision (3.5(d) Appendix UF).
- 2. UKR 300 is represented by Anna Kyselova.
- 3. LTU2074 is represented by Raimondas Siugzidinis.
- 4. Stavros Kouris and Georgii Paches, members of the International Jury, attended the hearing as observers.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind was 15 knots, gusting 18 knots with choppy waves of 1,5 metres.
- 2. 1:50 minutes before the start of race 5 UKR 300 was sailing on starboard tack.
- 3. LTU 2074 was sailing on port tack on a collision course with UKR 300.
- 4. LTU 2074 luffed and started to tack.
- 5. Before LTU 2074 passed head to wind UKR 300 bore away sharply.
- 6. If UKR 300 would have kept her course, contact would have occurred between the bow of UKR 300 and the port side of LTU 2074.
- 7. No boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: Appendix UF, RRS 13

After passing head to wind and before being on a close-hauled course, LTU 2074 failed to keep clear of UKR 300. LTU 2074 broke RRS 13.

LTU 2074 is penalized 30% applied to race 5, calculated to the nearest tenth of a point, (0.05 to be rounded upward), but not worse than the score for DNF. The scores of other boats shall not be changed as a result of this penalty.
