NOTICE OF RACE – Amendment 3, 2/27/23

The notation [NP] in a rule in the NOR means it shall not be grounds for protest. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta is governed by the rules as defined by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Rule 40.1 will apply when boats are in the racing area and on their way to and from the racing area.
- 1.3. [US Sailing Prescriptions](#) to rules 63.1 and 63.2 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to: 5o5, I420, C420, Opti Green, Opti Championship, RS Feva, RS Tera, ILCA 7, ILCA 6, ILCA 4.
- 2.2. Classes must have a minimum of six (6) boats registered by 3/14/23 to qualify for a start.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.stfyc.com/racing.

3. FEES

- 3.1 The entry fees are as follows:

- 3.2 Late fees go into effect on 3/14/23.
- 3.3 Entry fees are non-refundable on or after 3/14/23.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available online at or before the competitor's meeting at www.stfyc.com/racing.

6. RACING VENUE

- 6.1. The intended racing venue for the Opti Green, Opti Championship, RS Feva and RS Tera is Ft. Mason Cove.
- 6.2. The intended racing venue for the 5o5, I420, C420, ILCA 7, ILCA 6 and ILCA 4 is the west face of Alcatraz.

7. COURSES

The courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

8. SCORING

8.1 One (1) race will constitute a series.

8.2 When four (4) or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.3 When five (5) or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be given based on participation.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME, LIKENESS, AND PERSONAL INFORMATION

11.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

11.2 Additionally, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and race officials the right to use their personal contact information, including but not limited to a current email address and cell phone number, for the purpose of race administration and regatta communications.
