- 1. CHN 87 was represented by Wan Li.
- 2. POL 50 was represented by Julia Damasiewicz.
- 3. Ginger (coach of CHN 87) and [father of Julia] attended the hearing as observers.
- 4. Qu Chun (member of the International Jury) attended the hearing as translator for CHN 87.
- 5. POL 50 provided tracking evidence.
- 6. Hearing No. 4 was heard together with Hearing No. 3 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.
- 7. The panel of the International Jury was composed in accordance with RRS N1.4(b).

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The conditions at the time of the incident on the second upwind were 11-12 knots of wind and 0,5m waves.
- 2. CHN 87 was sailing on starboard-tack on a collision course with POL 50 on port-tack.
- 3. When POL 50 was 50m away from CHN 87, she bore away slightly and then passed 15m astern of CHN 87.
- 4. Neither kiteboard took a penalty.
