PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. POL 50 was represented by Julia Damasiewicz.
- 2. CHN 87 was represented by Wan Li.
- 3. Ginger (coach of CHN 87) attended the hearing as an observer.
- 4. Qu Chun (member of the International Jury) attended the hearing as translator for CHN 87.
- 5. The panel of the International Jury was composed in accordance with RRS N1.4(b).

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The conditions at the time of the incident on the second downwind were 11-12 knots of wind and 0,5m waves.
- 2. POL 50 and CHN 87 were sailing downwind on starboard tack with POL 50 being 30m clear astern and 30m to leeward.
- 3. CHN 87 lifted her kite and gybed to port tack.
- 4. Less than 5 seconds later, POL 50 lifted her kite, luffed and passed CHN 87's stern at a distance of 7m between the boards of CHN 87 and POL 50.
- 5. Neither kiteboard took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 10; World Sailing Case 50

- There was reasonable doubt that CHN 87 could have crossed, if POL 50 had not taken avoiding action (see WS Case 50)
- 2. CHN 87 on port tack failed to keep clear of POL 50 on starboard tack, and broke RRS 10.

DECISION

CHN 87 is DSQ in race 8.
