PROCEDURAL MATTERS

The jury was properly constituted under RRS N1.5

GER 1598 was represented by Silke Kinner

DEN 523 was represented by Bent Holm Nielsen

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind was 18 to 20 knots and the sea was choppy.
- 2. GER 1598 was sailing on beat to windward on starboard tack
- 3. DEN 523 was sailing on downwind on port tack
- 4. Both boats were on converging courses, aiming each other's bow
- 5. At 3 to 4 boat lengths, at the same moment, both boats luffed
- 6. Both boats heeled and collided with top sections of the masts
- 7. Wind indicator was lost on GER 1598
- 8. Backstay was broken on DEN 523
- 9. DEN 523 retired from the race
- 10. GER 1598 completed the race

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 10, 14, 64.2(a)

- 1. DEN 523 on port tack failed to keep clear of GER 1598 on starboard tack, and broke RRS 10.
- 2. DEN 523 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for GER 1598 the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with DEN 523 when it was clear that DEN 523 was not keeping clear. GER 1598 did not break RRS 14.
- 4. By retiring, DEN 523 took an appropriate penalty.
