PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. Eduardo Vietes (coach of BRA 85) attended the hearing as an observer.
- 2. CZE 57 provided video evidence (2 videos shot from different angles).
- 3. Ivan Doronin (coach of CZE 57) attended the hearing as a witness for CZE 57.
- 4. Jis Van Hees (NED 3)7 attended the hearing as a witness for BRA 85.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The conditions at the time of the incident were 14-16 knots of wind and small chopp.
- 2. In race F1, BRA 85 and CZE 57 were approaching mark 3 on starboard-tack.
- 3. When entering the zone of mark 3, BRA 85 was four metres clear ahead and one metre to leeward of CZE 57.
- 4. When approximately ten metres from the mark, BRA 85 took her kite up and luffed towards mark 3.
- 5. When two metres from mark 3, CZE 57 established an overlap to windward of BRA 85 at a distance of two metres between the kiteboards.
- 6. At the same time, contact but no tangle between the tips of the kites of BRA 85 and CZE 57 occurred and lasted three seconds.
- 7. When at the mark, contact occurred between the board and competitor of CZE 57 and marks 3 as well as between the board and body of BRA 85 and the board of CZE 57.
- 8. The competitor of CZE 57 fell into the water, recovered and finished the race. BRA 85 also finished the race.
- 9. No damage or injury occurred to either kiteboard.
- 10. Neither kiteboard took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 11, 14, F2.18.2(a)(2)

- 1. CZE 57 not overlapped with BRA 85 and not in the zone at the time BRA 85 reached the zone, failed to give BRA 85 mark-room, and broke RRS F2.18.2(a)(2).
- 2. CZE 57 to windward failed to keep clear of BRA 85 to leeward, and broke RRS 11.
- 3. CZE 57 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 4. It was not reasonably possible for BRA 85, the right-of-way kiteboard and kiteboard sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled, to avoid contact with CZE 57 when it was clear that CZE 57 was not keeping clear and not giving mark-room. BRA 85 did not break RRS 14.
