NOTICE OF RACE

1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The races will be organized by Istanbul Offshore Yacht Racing Club ("IAYYK").

2 RACE OFFICE

The Race Office can be contacted via email at sekreterlik@iayk.org. Additional addresses for communication will be announced through supplementary instructions specific to the Marmaris and Bodrum regions between July 24 and July 30, 2023.

3 APPLICABLE RULES

The races will be conducted in accordance with the Sailing Rules of the Presidential International Yacht Race Rules Of Racing 2023.

4 CLASSES, ELIGIBILITY, AND REGISTRATION

4.1 For all classes:

- Yachts with a minimum length overall (LOA) of 8 meters or more,
- Yachts equipped with an inboard diesel engine.

4.2 For IRC classes:

Yachts with an 2023 IRC Certificate.

4.3 For Cruising class;

Yachts that meet the specifications of the Cruising class, do not possess a valid 2023 IRC certificate, and comply with safety regulations, are eligible to participate. All sailing yachts, both domestic and foreign participants, must comply with the applicable regulations and instructions.

5 DIVISION BANDS AND DIVISION/WARNING FLAGS

IRC 0	The groups will be announced prior to the race based on the registered boats.	Pink
IRC 1	The groups will be announced prior to the race based on the registered boats.	Yellow
IRC 2	The groups will be announced prior to the race based on the registered boats.	Green

GEZGIN A	The groups will be announced prior to the race based on the registered boats.	White - Pink

- 5.1 The Race Organization Committee may merge classes/divisions with one lower or higher group or add a new division based on the number of registered boats until 18:00 on July 24, 2023. They also reserve the right to close a division.

6 REGISTRATION

- 6.1 Race registration must be completed through the Race Registration System available on our websites at

<https://sailturkey.racing>. The form available at the Online Race Registration System link <https://form.jotform.com/231275468050959> must be filled out completely by the boat owner or a designated responsible person in writing. The Boat Insurance Policy, advertising permit if the boat carries advertisements, and the authorization document given by the boat owner to the boat responsible person must be sent separately to sekreterlik@iayk.org.

- 6.2** In the Online Race Registration Form, all athlete names in the team must be written as stated on their ID cards. Otherwise, the registration will be invalid. All competitors, except foreign athletes on the boats, must have valid 2023 athlete licenses. Written parental consent is required for athletes under 18 years old. The boat owner/responsible person registering the boat is responsible for this. Temporary licenses will not be issued. Athletes without licenses cannot participate in the race.
- 6.3** THERE IS NO REGISTRATION FEE.
- 6.4** All registration procedures must be completed by 12:00 on Monday, July 24, 2023.
- 6.5** In case of any changes in the team list specified in the registration forms, this information must be notified to the race office in writing via email to sekreterlik@iayk.org or through the messaging application within the race application, no later than 1 (one) hour before the warning signal time announced for each day. Oral changes will not be considered. The presence of a competitor who is not listed on the team list or listed but not present on the boat may be grounds for disqualification by the Protest Committee.
- 6.6** The boat owner/responsible person who registers the boat for the race must be present on the boat during the races.
- 6.7** The races are open to all regions and foreign yachts and sailors, provided that they comply with the applicable regulations and instructions. A license requirement will not be imposed on foreign athletes.
- 6.8** The Race Committee is free to evaluate the general safety and seaworthiness characteristics of yachts wishing to participate in the race and decide whether to accept their registrations or not.

7 RACE START AND RACE PROGRAM

- 7.1** See General Conditions of the 2023 Presidential International Yacht Race Instructions, Article 9.
- 7.2** There will be a total of 4 races, consisting of 2 offshore races and 2 buoy races.
- 7.3** For the 1st offshore race on 25th July 2023, Tuesday, the first warning signal will be at 10:55. A single start may be given for IRC and CRUISING classes, and no warning signal will be given after 19:00.
- 7.4** For the inshore buoy races in Marmaris, on 27th July 2023, Thursday, the first warning signal will be at 11:55, and no warning signal will be given after 19:00.
- 7.5** For the 2nd offshore race on 28th July 2023, Friday, the first warning signal will be at 11:55. A single start may be given for IRC and CRUISING classes, and no warning signal will be given after 19:00.
- 7.6** If the warning signal has been made within the time limit and a general recall is signaled or if a postponement (AP) flag is raised due to an error in procedures, the race will proceed even if the announced time has passed.

8 RECALL

Boats that are individually recalled must identify themselves and return to the starting line to restart according to the rules. The Race Committee will notify these boats by calling their sail number/boat name or by making a general broadcast on VHF Channel 73. Such notification will not be considered outside assistance, and failure to hear it will not be grounds for redress.

9 COURSES

- 9.1** Route cards will be shared with additional instruction
- 9.2** **Warnings:** It is strongly advised to stay away from natural obstacles and shallow waters within the course.

10 ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

Alternative routes will be announced through Supplementary Instructions. The specific route to be followed in the alternative geographical route application will be announced to all participating boats via the VHF channel by hoisting the route flag with a number, without being late for the warning signal.

- 11 START LINE**
The line that separates the starboard side, where the Race Committee boat (Mark Boat) with an orange flag is located, and the port side, where the orange-colored buoy or the line boat with an orange flag is located.
- 12 FINISH LINE**
The definition of the finish line will be announced prior to each race through supplementary instructions.
- 13 START**
In the case of all classes starting together, a white flag will be hoisted as the class (warning) signal on the committee boat.
- 14 FINISH**
The coordinates of the finish buoy will be announced via radio when boats are approaching the finish. The finish line will also be shared in the WhatsApp group. Failure to hear the announcement is not grounds for redress. Boats approaching the finish line should declare their arrival to the committee via VHF Channel 73.
- 15 TIME LIMIT**
15.1 For the race starting on Tuesday, July 25, 2023, the time limit is until Wednesday, July 26, 2023, 21:00.
15.2 For the race starting on Friday, July 28, 2023, the time limit is until Sunday, July 30, 2023, 15:00.
- 16 ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT**
During the race, the provisions of Article 15 of the General Conditions of the Presidency International Yacht Race Regulations 2023 apply.
- 17 VHF (RADIO) COMMUNICATION**
The VHF channel to be used during the race is **Channel 73**. The provisions of Article 20 of the General Conditions of the Presidency International Yacht Race Regulations 2023 apply.
- 18 RACE CATEGORY**
The World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations (OSR) 2022-2023 Appendix B will be applied.
- 19 AWARDS**
19.1 Prizes will be awarded to the boats that finish first in their class based on corrected time in the Bodrum-Marmaris Open Sea Race.
19.2 The team that finishes first in the Marmaris-Bodrum Open Sea Race will be awarded the Line Honours Trophy.
19.3 Based on the overall results of the completed races, prizes will be awarded to the first, second, and third place finishers in each class.
19.4 University sailing teams competing in the IRC and Cruiser classes will receive special prizes for their top three placements based on overall results.
19.5 Female sailing teams competing in the IRC and Cruiser classes will receive special prizes for their top three placements based on overall results.
19.6 The definition of special categories (Female and university student sailing teams) is provided in Article 22.6 of the General Conditions of the Presidency International Yacht Race Regulations 2023.
- 20 EVENTS**
The dates and locations of the events to be held during the races will be announced by the race organizing committee through the race communication channels and the WhatsApp group.
- 21 PRIZE CEREMONY**
The prize ceremony will take place at Bodrum Castle and will commence on Sunday, July 30, 2023, at
