PROCEDURAL MATTERS

209216 did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).

FACTS FOUND

199865 and 209216 were both approaching the leeward right hand gate mark.

199865 was inside overlapped 209216 when it entered the zone.

199865 was hit on the port side by 209216 pushing her into the mark.

There was no damage. No penalties were taken.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: 14, 18.2 (b), 31, 43.1(b)

- 1. 209216 outside overlapped, failed to give 199865 mark-room, and broke RRS 18.2(b).
- 2. 199865 touched right hand gate mark and broke RRS 31.
- 3. 209216 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 4. Since 199865 broke RRS 31 while she was sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(b) for this breach.
- 5. It was not reasonably possible for 199865, the boat sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled to avoid contact with 209216 when it was clear that 209216 was not giving mark-room. 199865 did not break RRS 14.

DECISION

The Protest is Upheld

209216 is DSQ in race 5.
