# **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

### FACTS FOUND

- 1. In Race 9 the wind was 15-17 knots and the sea with slight chops.
- 2. 100 meters after the start, SGP214246 was on starboard and UAE 208904 on port and both on a converging course.
- 3. When they were about half a boat length apart, SGP214246 hailed "Starboard" and started bearing down to avoid colliding with UAE 208904.
- 4. To avert capsizing, UAE208904 released her mainsheet which caught SGP214246's bow which then pulled SGP 214246's bow to collide with UAE 208904's rear quarter.
- 5. SGP 214246 capsized immediately after the contact.
- 6. There was slight damage to SGP214246 with scuff marks on the bow's gel coat.
- 7. There was no injury.
- 8. No boats took any appropriate penalties.
- 9. Both boats completed the race.

# CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS10,14,

- 1. UAE 208904 on port failed to keep clear of SGP 214246 on starboard, and broke RRS 10
- 2. UAE 208904 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for SGP 214246, the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with UAE208904 when it was clear that UAE 208904 was not keeping clear. SGP 214246 did not break RRS 14.
