PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- Appendix T applied to the event.
- · Satish Kanwar was the arbitrator.
- IND 14 did not withdraw the protest after the arbitration meeting and neither boat accepted a Post-Race Penalty under RRS T1(a).
- Hearing No. 11 was heard together with Hearing No. 14 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind speed was 5-6 knots.
- 2. Tide was across the sailing area from pin end mark towards the committee end of the start line.
- 3. At the start line, 15 seconds before the start IND 59 was on a starboard tack 1 and a half boat length below the line.
- 4. IND 44 was to the windward of IND 59 with distance between the hulls being half a hull length.
- 5. At 7-8 seconds before the start, IND 14 established an overlap to the leeward side of IND 59 and immediately luffed.
- 6. IND 59 responded by luffing immediately.
- 7. There was a contact between the port quarter of IND 59 and the starboard side of the bow of IND 14.
- 8. Neither boat took any penalty.
- 9. There was no damage or injury.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 11, 14, 15, 43.1(b) and 43.1(c)

- 1. When acquiring right of way through her own actions, IND 14 failed to initially give IND 59 room to keep clear and broke RRS 15.
- 2. Since IND 59 broke RRS 11 while she was sailing within the room to which she was entitled, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(b) for this breach.
- 3. Since IND 14 was right-of way boat and the contact did not cause damage or injury, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(c) for breaking RRS 14.
