PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. GBR 2575 was represented by Ruby Sunderland.
- 2. RC came to the hearing while the hearing was in progress. RC was represented by Mark Wood.
- 3. Graham Sunderland, support person of GBR 2575, attended the hearing as an observer.
- 4. Cxema Pico, member of the International Jury took part in the hearing via Zoom online system.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. After the starting signal of race #4 of the Tera Pro fleet, GBR 2575 was sailing on starboard tack on close hauled.
- 2. The designated course for the Tera Pro fleet is an outer loop trapezoid course (O2).
- 3. The left mark of the inner loop leeward gate (3s) lost connection to the GPS.
- 4. The mark started moving randomly back and forth. At that time GBR 2575 was 3 boat lengths away form the mark.
- 5. GBR 2575 sailed on holding her course.
- 6. There was contact between GBR 2575 and the mark 3s. After the contact GBR started moving backwards for 5 sec.
- 7. GBR finished the race in 14th place.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 62.1

- 1. GBR 2575's score in race #4 may have been made significantly worse through her own fault. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.
- 2. There was neither an improper action nor omission of the race committee. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.
