





ORGANISING AUTHORITY

III. Mandarin Cup will be organized by Bodrum Municipality Bodrum Sailing Club between 3-7 January 2024 in Bodrum/Turkey.

1) RULES

- 1.1) The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024).
- 1.2) The first three sentences of RRS 61.1(a) are changed to 'The protesting boat shall inform the other boat at the first reasonable opportunity. When her protest will concern an incident in the racing area she shall hail 'Protest'. She shall inform the Race Committee at the finishing line immediately after finishing of the boat/s being protested, or as soon as practicable after she retires.'
- 1.3) RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 are changed as follows:
 - 1.3.1) The first sentence of RRS 40.1 is deleted and replaced by: "Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device (PFD) according to class rule 4.2 (a), properly secured at all times while on the water except when temporarily adding or removing clothing."
 - 1.3.2) Add to the preamble of Part 4, after 'racing': "...except rule 40.1 as amended by Sailing Instruction 1.3.1"
- 1.4) Rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.5) If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6) In all rules governing this championship, both "athlete" and "competitor" mean a person competing in the event. The term "support person" means a person as defined in RRS
 - [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty applied by the International Jury with a hearing. This changes RRS A5 and 63.1, and
 - [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1 (a).
- 1.7) English is the Official Language of the Championship. If there is a conflict between languages the language of the original version of the relevant document will take precedence

2 ADVERTISING

2.1) Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1) The Cup is open to Optimist and ILCA classes. The regatta is open to all nations (Except Russian and Belarussian).
- 3.2) Entries shall be made by submitting the online registration http://www.bodrumsporyelken.org/en/mandarin-cup/mandarin-cup-registration
- 3.3) Deadline for the entries is 15 December 2023.

- 3.4) Final registrations at the venue shall be made latest on Thursday, 3th January 2024 at 18.00 by the Race Secretary. Those who have their visa for licence in 2023 will be able to participate in the race (for Turkish Sailors).
- 3.5) Entry fee is 65 Euros.

4 FORMAT OF THE REGATTA

- 4.1) The fleet will be divided into divisions if the participants more than 80, as far as possible with the same number of boats.
- 4.2) The initial allocation to divisions will be done by the Race Committee on January 3th with the list of competitors already registered by the time of the allocation. Competitors registering later will be added at the bottom of the sorted list in the order of registration.
- 4.3) All details about the format of the regatta will be determined on Sailing Instruction.

6 MEASUREMENT

6.1) All competitors shall comply with the Class Rules. Boats may be checked at any time on shore and on the water.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1) The sailing instructions will be made available upon registration at the venue and official website (http://www.bodrumsporyelken.org/en/mandarin-cup).

8 VENUE

8.1) The Championship will be held in the city of Bodrum-Mugla. The shore venue will be B.B. Bodrum Sailing Club and the racing area will be in front of the venue.

9 THE COURSE

9.1) The course is shown in Sailing Instructions. Also can be found in attachment B

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1) Appendix P will apply.

11 SCORING

- 11.1) Low-point system of RRS App A will be applied.
- 11.2) 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3) When from 1 to 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score.
- 11.4) When from 4 and more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1) Them support boats shall be registered with the Organising Committee.
- 12.2) All support boats shall comply with the rules established by the Organising Committee.
- 12.3) Support boats shall stay outside the racing area where the boats are racing from the time of the first warning signal until all boats have finished or the Race Committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

 - * The three best-placed female competitors (U 16)
 - * The five best-placed junior competitors (U 12 born 2013 and after)
 - * The three best placed junior female competitors (U 12 born 2013 and after)
 - * The five best-placed bambinos competitors (U 10 born 2015 and after)
 - * The three best placed bambinos female competitors (U 10 born 2015 and after) ILCA Classes
 - * The five best competitiors in ILCA 4 overall
 - * Top three other each classes
- 16.2) Organizing committee may award special prizes. It will be stated in sailing instructions.

- 17.1) Competitors participate in the Championship entirely at their own risk and responsibility. See rule 4, Decision to Race.



ATTACHMNET A: RACING AREA





OPTIMIST




COURSE: START - 1 (PORT) - 2 (PORT) - 3 S/3 P (GATE) - FINISH
