PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Mina Stanikic (Chair of the International Jury) attended the hearing as an observer.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. In race 5 there was 8 knots of wind and marginal chop.
- 2. 4 to 5 minutes after the starting signal, BEL 11 and ITA 11 were sailing close-hauled on a collision course, with BEL 11 on starboard tack and ITA 11 on port tack.
- 3. When the distance between the boats was 4 meters, ITA 11 started tacking and then passed head to wind.
- 4. Before ITA 11 was on close-hauled on starboard tack, BEL 11 luffed and there was a contact between ITA 11's starboard corner of the stern and BEL 11's port side of the hull, ahead of the boat's midpoint, causing slight scratches on BEL11's hull.
- 5. No boat took any penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 13, 14

- 1. After passing head to wind and before being on a close-hauled course, ITA 11 failed to keep clear of BEL 11. ITA 11 broke RRS 13.
- 2. ITA 11did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. BEL 11 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 4. Since BEL 11 was right-of way boat and the contact did not cause damage or injury, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(c) for breaking RRS 14.

DECISION

ITA 11 is DSQ in race 5.
