#### **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. The mast of GBR 2156 broke during race #7 of the Tera Pro fleet.
- 2. The last boat of the Tera Pro fleet finished race #7 at 14:21.
- 3. The protest time limit for the Tera on 3/8/2022 was at 15:30.
- 4. GBR 2156 was not racing with a charter boat.
- 5. GBR 2156 came back ashore at about 14:40.
- 6. GBR 2156 lodged a question to the technical committee on RRoS.org at 16:21 on 3/8/2022.
- 7. GBR 2156 lodged the request at 16:41 on 3/8/2022, when she realized that the sleeve of the mast was missing and only after having shown her mast to RS.
