PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1. GBR 2156 was represented by Ffion Bailey
2. Jo Powell, mother of GBR 2156 attended the hearing as an observer.
3. Cxema Pico, member of the International Jury took part in the hearing via Zoom online system

FACTS FOUND

1. The mast of GBR 2156 broke during race #7 of the Tera Pro fleet.
2. The last boat of the Tera Pro fleet finished race #7 at 14:21.
3. The protest time limit for the Tera on 3/8/2022 was at 15:30.
4. GBR 2156 was not racing with a charter boat.
5. GBR 2156 came back ashore at about 14:40.
6. GBR 2156 lodged a question to the technical committee on RRoS.org at 16:21 on 3/8/2022.
7. GBR 2156 lodged the request at 16:41 on 3/8/2022, when she realized that the sleeve of the mast was missing and only after having shown her mast to RS.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY
