PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. Wind speed: 11-12 knots

- 2. In race 7 the race committee signalled a change of course for the windward mark by displaying flag "C" with repetitive sounds and "+" at the gate after the first downwind.
- 3. SI 12 states that the color of the change marks is yellow.
- 4. The race committee extended the course and set an orange mark as the change mark.
- 5. FRA 702 did not identify a yellow change mark till she realized that the first boats were approaching an orange mark.
- 6. At that moment FRA 702 was overstanding the port layline by about 3 boat lengths in a distance of 70-80 meters from the mark.
- 7. FRA 702 rounded the orange mark.
- 8. FRA 702 was at position 14-15 at the gate and at position 19 at the windward mark after the second beat.
- 9. FRA 702 did not lose more than 4 places by overstanding the layline and searching for a yellow change mark.
- 10. FRA 702 finished 19th in race 7.
- 11. FRA 702 qualified for the Gold Fleet.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 62.1; SI 12

- 1. By setting an orange change mark instead of a yellow change mark as required by SI 12, the race committee made an improper action.
- 2. FRA 702's place in race 7 and score in the series was not made significantly worse. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.
