5.2 There will be a daily briefing for competitors and support persons / team leaders in front of the race office one hour before the first scheduled warning signal of the day, except that on 14 May 2024 the briefing will be 90 minutes before the first scheduled warning signal.

6.3 The Opening series will be split into Qualifying Series and a Final Series. There will be 3 groups for men and 2 groups for women.

8.7 Course Marks will be:

Mark 1, 2, 3, 4, 5: Red cylindrical marks with white event branding

Mark P Green cylindrical mark

Finishing marks: RC vessel and blue/white cylindrical mark

Starting marks RC vessels or RC vessel and yellow cylindrical mark

### 12 COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 12.2 The Official Flag Pole is located at the beach marshall office in the launching area.
- 12.4 Flag K displayed with two sounds means 'Kiteboards are given time to change their equipment.

  Races not started are postponed. The warning signal will be made not less than 10 minutes after the flag is displayed.'
- 12.9 Class flags are:

### 18 PROTESTS, PENALTIES AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

18.2 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last kiteboard has finished the last race of the day for that fleet, or when AP over A, or N over A is displayed.

### 19 [DP] SUPPORT TEAMS INCLUDING SUPPORT TEAM VESSELS

19.6 In front of the launching area, support team vessels shall be moored close to the white mooring marks. Support team vessels shall keep clear of kiteboards leaving and returning ashore.
