

Rules and provisions for hauling and launching trolleys

See # 26 SI

1. PREAMBLE

- The OA has established a service to help competitors to make the hauling and launching operations quickly and safety.
- In order to launch and haul the boats quickly, the competitors have to cooperate with the Beach Master and his team, follow their indications and prescriptions.
- This document is issued referring to point 26 of the Sailing Instructions.

2. Arrangement of the boats on the pier and on the boat park

- The OA will establish the boat parking position for all the event and it cannot be changed without specific allowance by the Beach Master
- Once the boats are back from the racing area, they must be parked at their own position.

3. Launching

- No boat is allowed to leave its parking place until exposure of DELTA flag over Class flag (9-7-6-5)
- Only the boats which DELTA flag over Class flag is exposed are allowed to leave their places; competitors of those class/classes have to move tardily to the trailer ramp/pier. People of the Beach Master staff will help competitors to launch the boats and to place the trailers in a waiting area.

- No other people are allowed to stay and/or cross the launching area either then competitors launching their boats and the Staff people.
- The boats which DELTA over Class flag is not exposed must stay at their parking place until they are allowed to leave it.

4. Coming ashore entering in the harbor after racing

- Depending on which racing area Annex 2 of the SI the races have been sailed, competitors have to follow the following instructions:
- RACE AREA A: at the entrance of the Calasetta harbor competitors will find two yellow marks and a RIB. All boats have to stop close to the marks and the RIB. The RIB people will give the go to enter in the harbor to groups of at least 5 boats at the time. This is due to safety matters. This will also help the people ashore to supply a better and rapid service.
- RACE AREA B: two yellow marks and a RIB will be positioned 0.3 nm from the entrance of the Calasetta Harbor. As above, competitors have to stop close to the marks/RIB and follow the instructions of the RIB people. Groups of at least five boats at the time will be allowed to go into the harbor.

5. Hauling

- To haul the boat a staff member will help the competitor to leave and keep the boat meanwhile another member will supply a trailer.
- Except the last day of racing, for all the other days, the trailers will be supplied randomly.
- When the boat is positioned on the trailer, the competitor will bring the boat to the end of the boat ramp to the fresh water station where a staff member will help to wash the boat.
- Once the boat is washed, the boat has to be parked promptly to its parking position.
