PROCEDURAL MATTERS

The jury was properly constituted under RRS N1.5

AUT 252 (16) - BARCAROLO - was represented by Wolfgang REISINGER

GER 1755 (25) - JOJO WASSERSPORT / BINI - was represented by Micki LIEBL

Alen Kustic member of the Jury was called as a witness

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind was 10 to 15 knots, small chop
- 2. On the beat to windward, approaching mark 1 for the 1st rounding
- 3. AUT 252 was sailing on close hauled, above the lay line fetching the mark on starboard tack
- 4. GER 1755 was sailing on close hauled on port tack, 1 boat length below the port layline and the mark 1
- 5. GER 1755 was on converging course with AUT 252
- 6. GER 1755 starts to cross ahead of AUT 252
- 7. At less than 1 boat length from GER 1755, AUT 252 luffed sharply to avoid contact
- 8. A contact occurred between AUT 252 's bow and GER 1755 's backstay
- 9. GER 1755 tacked and took a 1 turn penalty on the reach, and became positioned behind AUT 252 after taking her penalty
- 10. Both boats finished the race

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 10, 14, 16.1, 64.2(a)

- GER 1755 on port tack failed to keep clear of AUT 252 on starboard tack, and broke RRS 10.
- 2. GER 1755 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for AUT 252 the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with GER 1755 when it was clear that GER 1755 was not keeping clear. AUT 252 did not break RRS 14.
- 4. GER 1755 took an appropriate penalty

The protest is upheld. Since GER 1755 took an applicable penalty, she is not further penalized under RRS 64.2(a).
