11. MEASUREMENT

11.1 All IODA Optimists shall produce a valid Registration Book and Sail Measurement Certificate and Sticker/Label/Patch/Button. A photocopy / soft copy to be enclosed with the Entry form. Measurements validated for the Telangana State Regatta will be valid for the Monsoon Regatta. Not applicable to Light and Green Fleet Boats. All Laser Boats must have an ISAF (WS) plaque and the Sails must have the Laser Class or ILCA Sticker/Label/Patch/Button and serial number to ensure that it is class legal.

20. ACCOMMODATION AND BOARDING (COVID RESTRICTIONS AND BUBBLE).

Cost of Lodging will be about Rs 80/- per person per day at the Youth Hostel (Boarding optional) and about Rs.4999/- per day at the Marriott Hotel on a 3 person per room basis with Breakfast and Dinner served at the Room.

The Covid testing will be conducted provided the sailor/coach/parent/guardian/staff also produce a valid RTPCR certificate of validity less than 72 hours prior and will once again be tested by the OAs representative on arrival before being moved from Quarantine of about 2 days before being allowed to the Regatta premises.

The Regatta premises will include the Youth Hostel, Marriott and the YCH and will serve as a bio bubble with no participant or coach of parent allowed to leave the bubble which will be served by OA fixed time transportation only.

Exit from the bubble will require another RTPCR test and quarantine and in the event of any participant found outside the bio bubble and there being time to re-enter for the event. The OA will be the sole decision maker in case immediate exclusion from the event is warranted based on logistics and cost and the participant may be excluded without a hearing.

All participants and escorts and staff are expected to abide by State and Central government regulations and those of the MOYAS and SAI and the OA that will be in force during their presence at the Regatta and during practice sessions.

All sailors are requested to abide by the State quarantine laws at the time of the regatta and ensure arrival at the venue well in time and at least 3 days in advance or as per the quarantine rules in place.

Teams can arrive for practice well before the event and partake of the accommodation and boarding as required.
