## NOTICE OF RACE

All participants to the race are aware of the requirements for containment and contrast measures against COVID 19, included in the protocol of the Italian Sailing Federation, and commit to follow the aforementioned requirements knowing that any contrary behaviour to these specific provisions will be detected and reported to the competent bodies of the organizing committee.

Notation in a rule of the Notice of Race:

S P	Rules for which a standard penalty can be applied by the Race Committee without holding a hearing (this modifies RRS 63.1 and A).
D P	Rules for which the penalties are at the discretion of the Protest Committee. The penalty for an infringement of Point 3.3 may be from a minimum of 20% up to disqualification, depending on the seriousness of the infringement committed.
N P	Rules that cannot be subject of a boat against boat complaint (this modifies the RRS 60.1(a).

PLACE AND DATE: Trieste, Dock IV, 02-03/10/2021

**RULES**: the regatta will take place by following the rules as defined in the 2021-2024 W.S. Rules of Regatta (RSS) and the F.I.V. Norms for the 2021 national sports activities. In case of conflict between the Notice of Race and the Race Instructions, Race Instructions shall prevail.

The "PROTOCOL FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF MEASURES FOR THE CONTRAST AND CONTAINMENT OF THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 IN AFFILIATED SPORTS CLUBS AND ASSOCIATIONS", version updated on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, or subsequent versions – from now on indicated as "PROTOCOL". An infraction to the "PROTOCOL" may determine the application of a (DP) from a minimum of 20% up to a disqualification, depending on the seriousness of the

infraction committed. The percentage will be figured based on the arrival order of the boat in all the races of the day the infraction has been committed on or based on the arrival order gained on the day closest to the infraction.

Add to RRS 61.1 (a): "The protesting boat **must** inform the Regatta Committee in regard to the boat/boats they intend to protest immediately upon arrival."

RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 are modified as follows:

The first phrase of RRS 40 is erased and exchanged with: "Every participant while on the water must wear a personal flotation device (PFD), as by RCO 4.2 (a), except for the brief time they may be changing apparel or personal equipment.

Diving suits and/or dry suits are not considered personal flotation devices.

Appendix "P" of the RRS will be applied (immediate penalties as by rule 42).

**ADMITTANCE**: the regatta is open to all helmsmen born in the years: 2006 – 2007 – 2008 – 2009 – 2010 – ("A" Junior Division) – 2011 – 2012 ("B" Cadets Division).

Eligible helmsmen may register by filling out the online form and sending by e-mail the required information as explained under the REGISTRATION section of the following Notice of Race.

Foreign competitor must be in possession of the membership card issued by their national authority. Italian competitors must also be up to date with their 2021 Class registration. Said documentation might be requested by the Regatta Secretariat at the completion of the registration process or at least two hours before the beginning of the program's first trial.

**ADVERTISMENT**: during the event forms of individual advertising are not permitted. Boats may be required to display publicity chosen or provided by the organizing authority as contemplated by the W.S. Regulation.

**REGISTRATION**: registration must be carried out through the appropriate link <u>https://forms.gle/MRtnBQvN3dYGyhWZ9</u> as show on the dedicated Barcolana Young website <u>www.barcolana.it</u> by 24.00 hours of September 29, 2021.

A competitor to be considered regularly registered must: Send an e-mail to <u>regate@svbg.it</u> with the subject "**Barcolana Young 2021 Registration n° #Sail Number Last Name-First name**" and attaching:

- FIV membership card with valid medical certificate,

- Copy of valid AICO class membership card,

- RC insurance with minimal coverage as required by FIV Norms for the 2021 National Sport Activity Organized in Italy (not necessary if in possession of FIV Plus membership);

- FIV form Attachment 3 – self certification of COVID 19 symptoms exemption, downloadable from the official register of the evet at <u>https://www.barcolana.it/barcolana-young</u>;

Please note: in case of a single wire transfer for multiple boats, indicate data for each boat.

Whereas documentation forwarded by e-mail results incomplete, completion must occur <u>at least two days before the</u> <u>beginning of the event</u>.

The official opening of the Regatta Secretariat, at DOCK IV of Trieste, only for strictly necessary matters and with access allowed to only one coach/representative for each team, will occur:

- Friday October 01 from 14:00 to 20:00 hours
- Saturday October 02 from 08:00 to 10:00 hours

**PROGRAMMA DELLA REGATA:** la regata si svolgerà nello specchio di mare antistante il Molo IV - Porto di Trieste con il seguente programma:

**Saturday 2 October 2021 -** 10:30 Skipper Meeting, online, through a link that will be available on the event page <u>https://www.barcolana.it/barcolana-young</u>.

The warning signal for the first heat will be given October 2, 2021 at 12:00 hours. The next day's warning signal's time will be communicated through a specific press release.

**Sunday 3 October 2021** – Races - No warning signal can be given after 16.00 hours of the last day of races, with the exception for classes competing in heats. In this case, if a heat starts by the deadline, the last heat will have to start within 30 minutes of the deadline.

If possible 6 races will take place, both for the Junior and Cadets classes and no more than 3 racesa day shall take place. Standings will be compiled based on current FIV Norms for Organized Sports Activities in Italy. Whereas a total of 4 or more heats have been completed, each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

A series is complete with any number of races run.

The award ceremony will take place following current FIV Protocol.

**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be available to all participants after the official opening of the Race Office on the official regatta website: <u>https://www.barcolana.it/barcolana-young</u>

**RANKINGS AND PRIZES:** The low point scoring system shall apply, as set forth in RRS Appendix A. After the fourth race, each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

Awards will be given to: 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> Junior Class competitors; 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Junior Class female competitors; 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> Cadet Class competitors;

1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Female Cadet Class competitors.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to award additional special prizes. 1 Optimist hull and 1 or more Olimpic Sails sail will be drawn during the ceremony. Other special gadgets provided by the class partners and the Organizing Committee may be drawn as well.

**MEASUREMENT CHECKS:** All boats, sails and equipment used in the race must be duly certified (no sail may be replaced without prior consent from the Race Committee). Random checks may be carried out throughout the event. All boats shall display the same number indicated in their measurement certification while racing. Any change must be authorised in writing by the Race Committee.









## **COACHES and Support Personnel:**

All coaches and support personnel <u>must register by filling out the registration form</u> downloadable from the event's website and sending it to the email address: **regate@svbg.it**, thus declaring:

- 1) the characteristics of their support boat;
- 2) that they accept the "rules regarding support personnel and support boats" as described in the Sailing Instructions;
- 3) the names of the Participants they are supporting;
- 4) to have a VHF radio on board.

Coaches and support personnel will abide by the technical and disciplinary directions of the Race Committee and the Protest Committee (CdP), which, in case of infraction, will be able to act based on rule 64.5.

**DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** As set forth by Fundamental Rule number 4, all competitors participate in the regatta racing entirely at their own risk and under the responsibility of their parental authority. The responsibility for the decision to participate in the regatta or to continue racing is theirs alone. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for damaged materials or personal injury sustained both at sea and/or on land as a consequence of the event, as set forth in the Notice of Race. Sailors shall decide, taking in account their skills, the wind strength, the sea conditions, the weather forecast and any other factor which should be taken into account by any good sailor, whether to participate in the regatta, to continue racing, or to withdraw.

**PHOTO AND TELEVISION RIGHTS:** All participants grant full rights and permission to the Organizing Committee to publish and/or broadcast with any media means, every photo or filmed shooting of persons or boats during the event, included but not limited to, television commercials and whatever can be used for their own editorial, publicity, or printed information.
