 - b. We concur with 3.6 Level A: All crew aboard shall be comprised of Group 1 competitors.
 - c. We concur with Sails
 - (i) 6.1 All sails shall comply with the class rules in effect on the date of delivery of the sail (rule 6.9) or at the 2019 San Francisco Cup event measurement. Any class legal sail (with or without a sail tag), whether owned, borrowed or chartered, may be used in the competition.
